

NET INFORMATION:

TCARA holds a weekly Sunday evening 2-meter net at 7:00 PM. The FM Frequency is 145.440 MHz with a minus off-set, PL Tone (T) of 136.5 Hz. & a Tone Squelch (T-SQ) of available. If Freq. 145.440 is down, the alternet Freq. will be 449.880Mhz. with a (-) offset, & PL 146.2Hz.

Freq. linked together are: The 145.440 MHz_ PL 136.5. and 449.880MHz_ PL 146.2. and 445.480MHz PL 131.8

If any one of them is down, the other two should be available.
