## **OUR 102nd SEASON CONCLUDES WITH INTENSITY - NUTS OPENS MAY 2!**

The Barnstable Comedy Club will present the intriguing drama, **Nuts** by Tom Topor and directed by Linda M. Stevens for its final production of the season.

The story follows Claudia Faith Draper, a divorcee turned high-class call girl who killed a violent “john.” The State charges her with manslaughter, but she claims self-defense. When her mother, Rose Kirk, and stepfather, Arthur, try to avoid an embarrassing public trial by having her declared mentally incompetent even though it means she’ll spend the rest of her life in a mental hospital, Claudia launches a fierce battle to convince the court that she is sane enough to stand trial. As testimony from experts, physicians and her parents unfolds, the painful truth about Claudia’s childhood is exposed. The play is based on a real life legal case. A Broadway hit, **Nuts** has been called the best courtroom melodrama since **Witness for the Prosecution** and **The Caine Mutiny Court Martial**.
