Dear Mr. Knowlton:

Pursuant to 25 Pa. Code §127.43a, Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company, L.L.C. (TGP), a subsidiary of Kinder Morgan, is notifying you of its intent to submit a Plan Approval application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PADEP) to add a combustion turbine-driven compressor and associated equipment at TGP's existing Compressor Station 321 as part of TGP's East 300 Upgrade Project. Compressor Station 321 is located in Clifford Township, Susquehanna County, Pennsylvania and is operated under Title V Permit No. 58-00001.

The project emission sources include one (1) natural gas-fired Solar Taurus 70 combustion turbine, one (1) natural gas-fired emergency generator, one (1) small natural gas-fired hot water boiler, and a small above ground pipeline liquids storage tank and an associated truck loading operation.


