#### A MESSAGE FROM WALK #227 LAY DIRECTOR

#### Emmaus Friends,

I am humbled and honored to serve as Lay Director for the 227th Walk of the Central Alabama Emmaus community! Reflecting on my journey since my first walk, I am in awe of how my life has been blessed and transformed by God through the Walk to Emmaus experience.

My first walk was #125 in January of 2010. I arrived at Camp Alamisco on a 23-degree night, and like many of us, I really was not sure what was ahead. I remember leaving Emmaus feeling like I had been drinking through a fire hose for three days. Reflecting on that time, at least three things stand out. First, I was blown away by the relationships with Christ that others in the Conference Room were experiencing. Second, the love I felt and saw that weekend was real and visible, and it was a picture of what God's people can be. Finally, I remember realizing I would never experience communion the same again, either.

My spouse, Julia, attended Walk 130, it is special to share this Emmaus experience with her. The relationships we have formed will go far beyond the time of Walk 227, and we are grateful for the friends that God brought into our lives through Emmaus that we may not have otherwise met. For the past several months of preparation, it has been wonderful to see God at work through forming the Walk. When I was contacted about possibly serving as lay director for the walk in March, it was a little earlier than I and others perhaps had anticipated. I remember the person saying, "We're desperate". I went home and told Julia, and she said, "Are they desperate?" I went to my Emmaus group, and someone there said, "They must be desperate." I realized God must be telling me something. In a world that seems to be turning away from God or simply not making him a priority, Emmaus is different. We are a people for whom God is very much alive and in charge, and our world is indeed desperate for God and for more people to make a difference for his kingdom. We are the people who make a difference for our families, our churches, our communities, and among those who live on the margins of life. So, my encouragement is to keep inviting, keep sponsoring, keep serving, and keep leading as God directs you. You are making a difference in your Fourth Days, and for that, I am most thankful and humbled by this incredible opportunity.

I am thankful for the many prayers that have been lifted for the pilgrims, the support team, and the conference room team. As Walk #227 approaches, please continue to join me in praying that each pilgrim will meet God in a special way during their three-day journey. Pray that they will be "open-eyed, wide-eyed" (The Message version of Luke 24: 30-31) as they recognize and experience the risen Christ. And pray that they will return to their communities with a fire that cannot be extinguished and with a desire to live out the fruits of the spirit to the fullest measure!



# CAMP ALAMISCO LODGING INFORMATION

**Lodge/Cabins:** available on a first come first serve basis. They have bunk beds and community showers/bathrooms. Per bunk, they rent for \$25/night, or \$75 for the weekend. Three meals are included per day. You must provide all of your own linens.

**Campsites:** 3 spots available, where you can bring your own motor home. The campsite rates are \$30/night or \$90 for the weekend, and includes three meals for two people.

**Alamisco Inn:** which features three "suites" upstairs, that includes TWO queen beds, ONE set of bunk beds, and ONE pull out sectional "single bed" sleeper. It also has its own kitchenette.

**Suite #1** (Accommodates 6 People) is \$100/night or \$300 for the weekend.

**Suite #2** (Accommodates 4 People) is \$67/night or \$200 for the weekend.

**Suite #3** (Accommodates 6 People) is \$100/night or \$300 for the weekend.

\*\*All Suites - All Linens are provided.

**Downstairs Rooms** (One double bed) are \$45/night or \$135/weekend.

\* Downstairs Rooms - Linens are provided.

\*All Alamisco Inn Suites include three meals for 4 people included in the cost of the suite.

For those at camp not staying in lodgings: Meals - Breakfast \$5.00, Lunch \$5.00, Dinner \$8.00.

It is the policy of The Central Alabama Emmaus Community as well as The Upper Room - Emmaus Ministries, that ONLY persons that have completed a 3-Day Weekend (Emmaus, Chrysalis, Cursillo, Tres Dias, etc.) may participate in and attend:
