

OPPORTUNITIES FOR DEVELOPMENT**POLICY**

Planning is the process by which essential goals and objectives of District 24 programs are defined in order to provide overall guidelines for the operation of the District. Primary responsibility for planning resides with members of the Board and the Superintendent of Schools. The Board may from time to time appoint various others, such as members of staff, PTA, and other public groups, as it sees fit to assist in the planning of specific projects.

The Superintendent of Schools shall report to the Board on planning progress and seek input from the Board with respect to planning goals, objectives, and processes.

The Board is committed to a program of systematic evaluation directed at determining the extent to which the goals and objectives of the District programs are being met. The Superintendent of Schools is directed to carry out such an evaluation of programs and to periodically report to the Board on its outcome.
