

REGULAR MEETING
TOWN OF DELCAMBRE
JANUARY 13, 2020

Town of Delcambre regular session convened at 6:00 p.m. on JANUARY 13, 2020 at the City Hall, with Mayor Pam Blakely, presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

ALSO, PRESENT: Town Clerk Shirley Wyles, Town Attorney Ted Ayo, Street Commissioner Homer Stelly, Sellers & Associates representative Larry Cramer, Guidry and Associates representatives Keith Guidry and Glenn Armentor, BCBS representative Bill Hobbs and 5 guests.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timothy Derise and seconded by Alderwoman Madison Saunier "moved to accept and dispense the minutes of the regular meeting of December 09, 2019 as reviewed." Motion Carried:

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timothy Derise and seconded by Alderman Bryan Glatter "moved to authorize payment of monthly bills as reviewed and approved." Motion Carried:

DISCUSSION: Keith Guidry and Glen Armentor, representatives of Guidry & Associates and Bill Hobbs of Blue Cross Blue Shield of Louisiana presented options for employees 65 years of age and older. These options could save the Town approximately \$38,000 per year. The Town would no longer carry full coverage for those employees but instead provide an allowance to cover the cost of the supplemental plan and prescription plan. Item is to be placed on February's agenda. Town Clerk is to contact Medicare in regards to those employees 65 and over enrolling in Part B, which is required before acquiring a supplemental plan.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderman Timothy Derise "moved to approve discussion of property donation located at LeBlanc Small Boat Harbor Road by Eddie LeBlanc." Item is now open for discussion.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Bryan Glatter and seconded by Alderman Timothy Derise "moved to table ORDINACE - **SEC. 2-55 Compensation of Municipal Officers** until February for further clarification of titles to be included as Municipal Officers and Department Heads." Motion Carried.

MOTION: Introduced by Alderman Timothy Derise and seconded by Alderman Bryan Glatter "moved to Introduce ORDINACE - **Sec. 4-2. Fireworks;** (B) Possession; Sale; (4) To the Possession, Use, Explosion and Ignition On the Following Holidays: A. July 4; Or B. December 23 through January 1; To Be Permitted Between the Hours of 7:00 A.M. and 10:00 P.M. and Additionally On January 1 Until 2:00 A.M. and during the day On January 1 as above enumerated. Amending dates of sale to the week prior to and on July 4th and December 20th through January 1st Public Hearing to be held on February 10th at 5:50PM" Motion Carried.
