




There is nothing better than a nice sunny day for me. When it is a sunny day, the birds fly and normally there is not a Cloud in the sky.












Sally why don't you tell all that nice boys and girls about yourself. I am a small bird about16 Cm in length and I weigh between 0.85-1.39 OZ



How do we look? Females and young sparrows are colored pale brown and grey, and males have brighter black, white, and brown markings.




I feed mostly on the seeds of grains and weeds, but on occasions I don't mind eating insects and many other foods.

Who Sally. You know I love for birds to fly and land on my branches.


