Worshipping Indoors Again – Frequently Asked Questions

Who's been guiding the congregation's future indoor worship plans? Last May, a group of CLC members began meeting to discuss & make plans for us to worship together safely and faithfully. The Back-to-Worship Task Force is comprised of staff, health professionals, worship and property committee members. The group has met monthly to discuss guidance from CDC, VDH, and the VA Synod – ELCA.

Why are we waiting until July 4 to begin Sunday worship indoors? As we await more guidance from the VDH and the VA Synod-ELCA, we will be preparing the building, the technology, and recruiting volunteers.

What precautions will be in place for indoor worship? At first, all people will be asked to wear masks for the safety of those who are unvaccinated. We will continue to practice social distancing of at least three feet. Those who wish to sing during worship will be invited to do so softly.

I'm vaccinated, why should I wear a mask? Until everyone has had the opportunity to receive the vaccine, we will all wear masks to ensure the safety of the most vulnerable among us. As St. Paul writes in 1 Corinthians 8: "... take care that this liberty of yours does not somehow become a stumbling block to the weak."

Why are we continuing the Drive-In Service? For various reasons, many of our members and friends do not yet feel safe gathering in groups indoors. We will continue to worship outside, at least through the summer, to give everyone an opportunity to worship in-person with our siblings in Christ. (It's also a whole lot of fun!)

Why have we waited longer than some other congregations to worship in the sanctuary? At Christ Lutheran, we have been incredibly blessed by the configuration of our building and parking lot. We have been able to worship outside more comfortably and reverently than some of our sister congregations who do not have a portico facing a large open space.

Will we continue to live-stream worship? We plan to live-stream our services indefinitely in order to worship with as many people as possible.

What about congregational and other community gatherings in the building? Some groups, such as AA, are meeting in our facility while following mask and social distance guidelines. Monday Morning Bible Study has also begun meeting in the Fellowship Hall, with the option of joining in via Zoom. If your group would like to begin meeting in the building again, please contact the church office.

Beginning July 4, the Drive-In Service will start an hour earlier at 9am and will continue to be live-streamed on Facebook Live. At 10:30am, we will worship together in the sanctuary! At first, for indoor worship, we will continue to socially distance and wear masks since many among us have not yet had the opportunity or are unable to receive the vaccine.

July 4 may seem like a long wait after a long year, but we are hopeful that these next few weeks will give us the opportunity to adequately prepare. In the coming weeks, please watch for volunteer opportunities. We will continue to need people to help with the Drive-In service as well as people to help with the indoor services. Keep an eye out for details about fellowship events between Sunday services as well!

As always, know that I am grateful for your faithful ministry and for the opportunity to serve our loving God with you!
