

DRINKING WATER NOTICE

Monitoring requirements not met for RICHWOOD VILLAGE PWS

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During June 2023, we “did not monitor or test” or “did not complete all monitoring or testing” for Total Coliform Bacteria, and therefore, cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

What Should I Do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. **You do not need to boil your water or take other corrective actions.**

This notice is to inform you that RICHWOOD VILLAGE PWS did not monitor and report results for the presence of the contaminants listed above in the public drinking water system during the First Quarter of 2023 time period, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.

What Is Being Done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the above mentioned parameters. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate and timely monitoring will be performed in the future.
