**Market Animal Auction:** Motion by Kampen that the weigh in for any animals be postponed until early February (at which time it will be known as to what and how many animals are going to be shown at the fair; second by Krueger; motion carried.

Wolsdorf will be sending out questionnaires to all 4-H, FFA, and youth participants as to what animal(s) they will be showing and/or selling at the 2021 fair.
