Canned vegetables 	<p>Comfort Foods:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Coffee , sugar, creamer 2. Tea bags 3. Crackers, peanuts, Candy 4. Beef Jerky
<p>Emergency Supplies:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. For Cooking: wood stove, Propane gas grill – <i>fill the propane tanks</i> 2. Lighting: flashlights, batteries, candles 3. Spiritual: Bible 4. Sanitation: Toilet Paper, hand soap. 5. Medicines: Aspirin, alcohol, First Aid kit. 6. Money: Keep most of your Savings hidden in your home, not in the bank. 7. Tools: Crescent wrench, pliers, hammer, screw drivers set. 	<p>Luxury Supplies:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sanitary: Women's sanitation pads, dish soap, detergent, wipes. 2. Storage: Garbage bags, zip-lock bags 3. Power: gas generator, solar panels 4. Communication: two-way radios, CB radios, HAM radio. 5. Security Safe

Clothing: If winter have Jackets, Blankets, boots, gloves, beanies 	<p>Recommended (not emergency yet)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Home Protection: club, bat, handgun, shotgun, Ammunition 2. Garden Seeds (grow your own food)
<p>Emergency Transportation:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Extra gas tanks, extra engine oil, antifreeze 2. Keep car tank above half-full. 3. Extra tire, jack, lug wrench 4. Maps of your state, Compass, 5. Get Home Bag – emergency 3 day survival supplies to walk home. 6. Basic Tools & Flashlight 7. 	<p>Other things:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - GPS - - - -

Spiritual Preparedness for the Christian:

Luke 12:35-40 "Be dressed in readiness, and keep your lamps lit. 36 "Be like men who are waiting for their master when he returns from the wedding feast, so that they may immediately open the door to him when he comes and knocks. 37 "Blessed are those slaves whom the master will find on the alert when he comes; truly I say to you, that he will gird himself to serve, and have them recline at the table, and will come up and wait on them. 38 "Whether he comes in the second watch, or even in the third, and finds them so, blessed are those slaves. 39 "But be sure of this, that if the head of the house had known at what hour the thief was coming, he would not have allowed his house to be broken into. 40 "You too, be ready; for the Son of Man is coming at an hour that you do not expect.""

The Constant Preparedness of the Heart:

Lk 21:34-36 " Be on guard, so that your hearts will not be weighted down with dissipation and drunkenness and the worries of life, and that day will not come on you suddenly like a trap; 35 for it will come upon all those who dwell on the face of all the earth. 36 "But keep on the alert at all times, praying that you may have strength to escape all these things that are about to take place, and to stand before the Son of Man.""

Lk 21:25-28 " There will be signs in sun and moon and stars, and on the earth dismay among nations, in perplexity at the roaring of the sea and the waves, 26 men fainting from fear and the expectation of the things which are coming upon the world; for the powers of the heavens will be shaken. 27 "Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. 28 "But when these things begin to take place, straighten up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near.""
