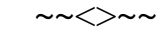

## **March Show N Tell: Jars**

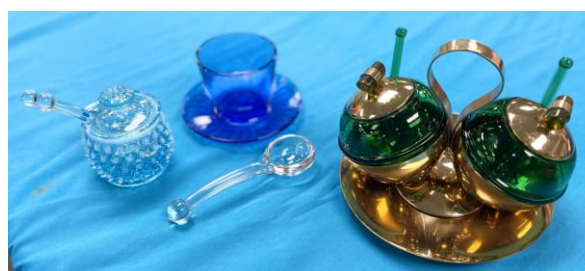
