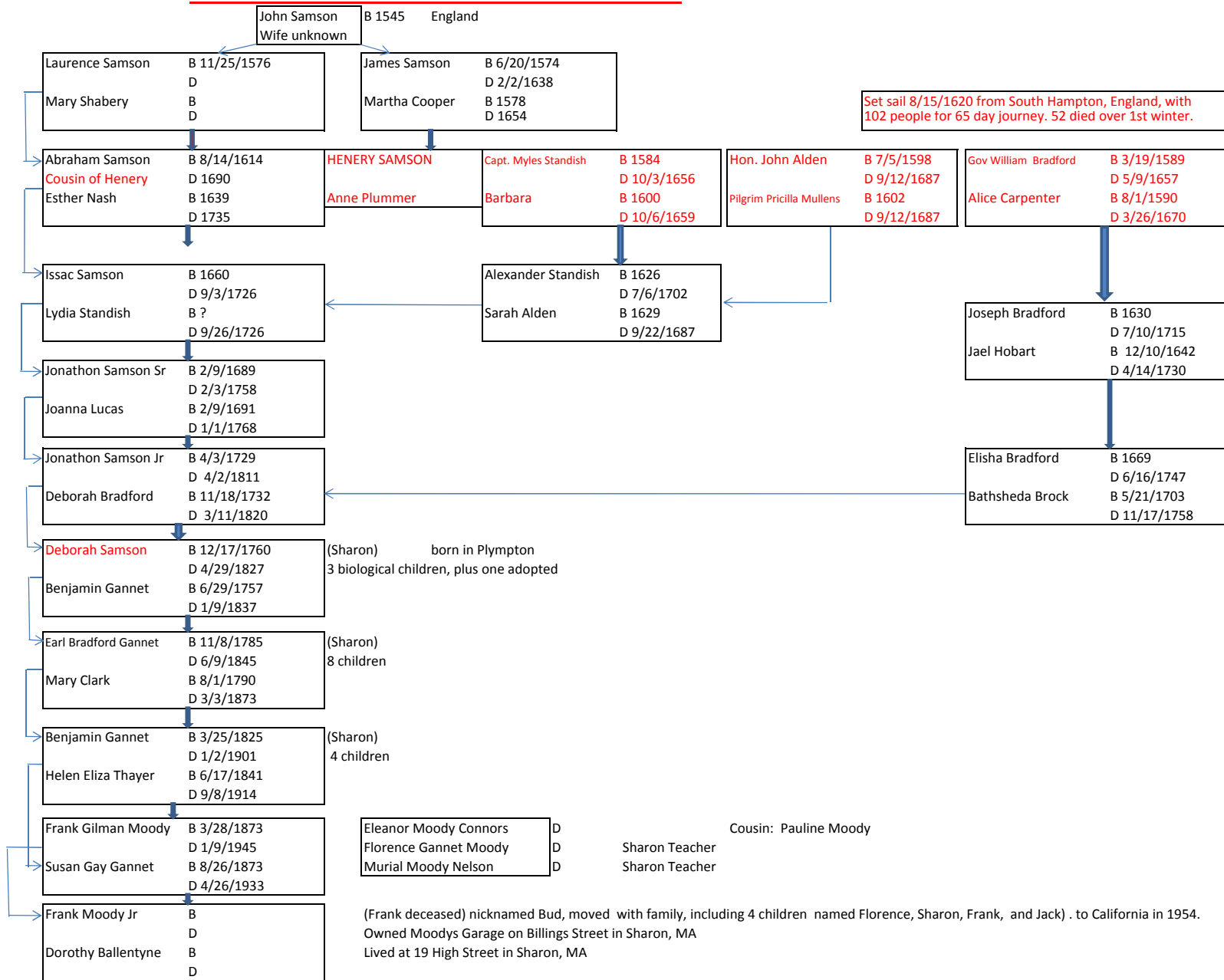


Deborah Samson MAYFLOWER DECENDENTS



THE SAMSON LINE

Abraham Samson came from England; settled in Duxbury. He was the brother of Henery Samson. (Mayflower passenger , 1620). Abraham came to America in 1629. In 1643, was listed, "as able to bear arms" in Duxbury. He was an original grantor of Bridgewater, 1645, surveyor of highways, constable and admitted freeman of Plymouth Colony in 1654. He was still living in 1686. He married Esther Nash, the daughter of Lieut. Samuel Nesh (wifes name unknown) who was born in England 1602. Abraham is reported to have had a 2nd wife (name unknown). The children born to them were: Samuel, George, Abraham, Sarah, Sarah, and Isaac.

ISAAC SAMSON and LYDIA STANDISH

ISAAC SAMSON

Son of Abraham and Esther (Nash) Samson

Born - ca 1661

Died - September 3, 1726 Plympton @ 66 years

Married - shortly after October 26, 1686

LYDIA STANDISH

Bdaughter of Alexander and Sarah (Alden) Standish

Granddaughter of John and Pricilla (Mullins) Alden

Born - ca 1660/61 Duxbury

Died - before June 13, 1688

NOTES: On September 28, 1726, Isaac Samson Jr. was appointed administrator of the estate of his father Isaac Samson of Plympton. On March 20, 1733/34, Jona (probably Jonathan) Samson of Plympton, husbandman, quit-claimed to Ephriam Samson of Plympton, cordwainer, his right in the estate of Josiah Samson, late of Plympton. On the same day, Isaac Samson made a similar quit-claim as did Peleg Samson of Plympton, nailer, along with Lydia Samson (Jr.) and Pricilla Fuller, widow of Plympton, and Barnabas Samson, same town, cordwainer. Lydia Samson, widow, also quit-claimed her share.

Daughter of Binoni and Repentance (Harlow) Lucas

Born - February 9, 1691 Plymouth

Died - January 1, 1768 Plympton @ 77 years

NOTES: Daughter Joanna born July 31, 1723, died January 22, 1784 in Plympton in her 61st year, unmarried.

On March 9, 1758 Joseph Perry of Plympton, was appointed administrator of the estate of Jonathan Samson of Plympton, husbandman. On April 2, 1759 the estate was divided between Joanna Samson, widow, son Jonathan Jr., daughters Mary, Joanna, Pricilla (wife of Jonathan Perry), Abigail and Bethiah Samson.

On October 31, 1769, Joseph Samson of Plympton and wife Berthiah; Joanna Samson spinster; Abigail Prior of Bridgewater, widow, sold to Nathan Perkins of Plympton, land set out by their mother, Joanna Samson late, of Plympton, from the estate of their father Jonathan Samson.

On February 4, 1797, Mary Perkins of Plympton, widow, and Berthia and Joseph Samson of Plympton, widow, and Berthia and Joseph Samson of Plympton, sold to Jonathan Samson of Sterling, Lincoln County, Massachusetts their rights to land in Plymouth, laid out to their grandfather, Benoni Lucas, and from him decended to their mother, Joanna Samson, late of Plympton.

Joanna's name is spelled Joanah and Joannah.

JOANATHAN SAMSON JR.

Son of Jonathan and Joanna (Lucas) Samson
Born - April 3, 1729 Plympton
Died probably Fayette, Maine after April 2, 1811
Married - October 27, 1751 Plympton

DEBORAH BRADFORD

Daughter of Elisha and Batsheba (LeBroche) Bradford
Born - November 18, 1732 Kingston
Died - after March 11, 1811 Fayette, Maine

NOTES on CHILDREN:

Jonathan, brother of Deborah, born ca 1753, married before November 27, 1780 Bertha (Edson) Borden, widow of Consider Borden, daughter of Abel and Margaret (Conant) Edson. Jonathan served in the Revolutionary War; was living in Middleboro when 1770 Census was taken. Book 4:61.

Their children - Olive born June 13, 1781 married Nathaniel Doty. Levi born March 26, 1783, Parnel born April 26, 1788 married

Thomas Howard, Hannah born July 5, 1789, Lucy born March 9, 1789, Jonathan born June 20, 1791, and Berthis born July 8, 1789.

Elisha, brother of Deborah, date of birth unknown. He may have been the Elisha Samson who enlisted in the Revolutionary War from Duxbury and died in New York. Duxbury V.R. page 409.

Hannah, sister of Deborah, date of birth unknown, married in Halifax on April 10, 1785 to Benajmin Bosworth. M.D.7:42.

Ephraim, brother of Deborah, died before 1814; married 1st at Middleboro on July 27, 1783, Elizabeth (Edson) Borden, widow of Rudolphus Borden, daughter of Abel and Margaret (Conant) Edson. Married 2nd at Plymouth January 9, 1808, Mary (Polly) Covill, who married 2nd Samuel Gibbs. Ephraim served in the Revolutionary War and was living in Middleboro when the 1790 Census was taken. His children include:

(by first wife) Born Middleboro. Book 7:70. Ephraim, Sylvie born June 14, 1784, married Jeremiah Thomas as his 3rd wife, Thomas, Polly married Abraham Thompson, Pricilla born November 28, 1785 married 1805 Nathan Lucas.

His children - (by 2nd wife). Theodore born about 1810 - lived in Nantucket.

Deborah, born December 17, 1760; died April 29, 1827. See Gannett line for Deborah Samson and Benjamin Gannett Jr.

Children include:

Earl B. Gannett, born November 8, 1785, died June 9, 1845. Married Mary Clark

Patience Gannett: born November 25, 1790, died July 11, 1865. Married Seth Gay July 6, 1812

Mary (Polly) Gannett Born December 19, 1797, Died 1855.

Sussana (Shepard) Gannett (adopted)

Nehemiah, brother of Deborah, was born July 17, 1764 Sharon, died in Rochester, New Hampshire April 26, 1818. Married October 1, 1789 in Sharon, Bathsheba Baker. Daughter of Elijah Baker. Bathsheba born April 22, 1770 Sharon. Died February 21, 1850 Lincoln, Maine. Nehemiah and his family removed from Stoughton and Sharon, MA to Readfield, Maine 1799-1800 where Nehemiah was a pioneer physician.

Their children were:

Jael born Stoughton December 20, 1789, died Lincoln, Maine July 20, 1850

Jonathan born May 5, 1792, died Barnstead, New Hampshire October 9, 1831. Death by fall from barn frame.

Susanna born December 26, 1793. Sally, born March 20, 1796, married Samuel Genes at Rochester, New Hampshire.

Polly born November 7, 1798 married _____ Hill.

James born August 22, 1805 Readville, Maine, died October 20, 1887 at Allendale, Rhode Island.

Luther born December 12, 1808, died 1884 Readville, Maine.

Sylvia, sister of Deborah, born April 1, 1766 (Plympton V.R. page 178), died Middleboro January 27, 1836, buried in Plympton.

Married Jacob Cushman at Plympton April 16, 1836 (Plympton V.P. page 381), who was born February 29, 1747 and died July 11, 1842. Their children were:

Jacob, born April 30, 1800, married Olive Samson Doty.

Irene, born November 3, 1801, married Otis Soule.
Winslow Bradford, born May 1, 1804, married Mary Tower.

Jonathan Samson Jr. deserted his family about 1767 and lived in Maine with a common-in-law wife named Martha. Deborah (Bradford) Samson, the widow of Jonathan Samson Jr. was moved from Plympton to Fayette, Main by the town of Fayette , Maine on November 19, 1810. She was living March 11, 1811. An extensive account of this family appears in MQ48:172-177.
