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The message of Jesus to His disciples was that He had come to establish the kingdom. That made them look forward to that with hope. So, when He was crucified, they were disappointed, that was why some of them decided to go back fishing, their former way of life. They regained their confidence when He appeared to them several times. The moment that they wanted to know whether it was time for the establishment of the kingdom, that was when He was taken up to heaven. Another disappointment?

The Lord had told His disciples several times that He would go away but would come back. This was what the angels also told them when they were looking up. It was made clear to them that it was by His going away that would enable the Holy Spirit to come to help them and all disciples. If they remembered what He had told them that He was going to prepare a place for them and come back to take them, then the disappointment would not be great; (Jn.14:2-3).

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
