

The students learned about where monkeys live, what they eat, how they move and how they play! They all had a great time counting monkeys in a tree, too!




















Rooms 60 and 61 Hold Scooter Races

Teacher Judy Stillwell and the children in Room 223 have been busy learning about colors and rainbows!




MacArthur High School Holds 4th Annual Lacrosse For Autism Event
