

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO
ORDINANCE: O-2015-11**

**AMENDING ORDINANCE O-2015-07 TO CORRECT THE SALARY FOR THE
ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT TO THE POLICE CHIEF POSITION AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Village Council passed Ordinance No. 2015-07 establishing the position of Administrative Assistant to the Police Chief, appointing Linda Sheeley to that position, and establishing a salary for the position; and

WHEREAS, the salary was incorrect in the original ordinance and Council desires to amend the ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, a majority of its members concurring, that:

SECTION I. That Section IV of Ordinance O-2015-07 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Mrs. Sheeley's starting salary in the position of Administrative Assistant to the Police Chief shall be \$17.60 per hour, effective January 12, 2015.

SECTION II. That existing Section IV of Ordinance O-2015-07 is hereby repealed.

SECTION III. Amelia Village Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and, that all deliberations of the Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in the formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to approve this to correct the pay rate for the Administrative Assistant to the Police Chief at the earliest possible time for the continued public safety of the Village. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates;


