Article II Section 2

The By-Law Committee has made a recommendation of a change of a By-Law

**Section 2. Applicants.** Applicants for membership in the Branford Gun Club Inc. must be endorsed (sponsored) by a member in good standing. At the meeting at which the applications are voted upon, the sponsor must be present, and all fees must be presented. A secret ballot shall be taken to accept or reject the applicant with a minimum of three (3) dissenting votes needed to disqualify him. In the event an applicant is disqualified because of three or more dissenting votes, the application will be tabled and the Membership Committee Chairman or the president will read the following: "This applicant (name of applicant) has been disqualified by three or more dissenting votes. Those dissenting, having legal, moral, or any other valid reason to deny this applicant membership in the Branford Gun Club must, before the next regular meeting of this Club make their reasons for denying membership known to the Chairman of the Membership Committee or to any officer of the Club. The names of the dissenting voters will be kept in strict confidence. However, their reason for denying membership will be given to the Membership Committee. The Membership Committee will meet and take the following action

Those dissenting, having legal, moral, or any other valid reason to deny this applicant membership in the Branford Gun Club must, before the next regular meeting of this Club make their reasons for denying membership known to the Chairman of the Membership Committee or to any officer of the Club. The names of the dissenting voters will be kept in strict confidence. However, their reason for denying membership will be given to the Membership Committee. 
**Section 4. Closing of Membership.** A. As membership grows beyond the 225 members resources of the Club, all new applications for regular membership shall be tabled.


