The Mineral County Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) program provides trained supervised community volunteers, who advocate on behalf of abused and neglected children in the Mineral County 21st Circuit Courts, to ensure permanency and safety is achieved.

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ABOUT FOSTER CARE AND KINSHIP

Foster care is a temporary arrangement in which adults provide care for a child or children whose birthparent is currently unavailable to care for them. Kinship placement can also be temporary care; however, it is provided by a family member related to and trusted by the child's family of origin. Both placements can be informal or arranged through the courts or a social service agency. The goal for a child in foster care and kinship placement is usually reunification with the birth family but may be changed to a more permanent solution such as adoption when it is in the child's best interest.
