

HEALING THE NATIONS  
As God Uses His Gauntlet,  
The Switch and Our Shift  
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Part Two

In Part Two of our three-part article, I want to repeat something I wrote in Part One, before we look at our topic this month. I am not of the opinion that the “shift” I have shared is part of a doom and gloom narrative some in the Body of Christ have preached. That is due in part to what I hear the Holy Spirit saying, and also what the hard-copy science has shown when it comes to evidence left behind on our planet from past earth-magnetic-field shifts. As I shared last month when the Lord gave me that word back in 2002, I thought it was spiritual only, with no physical application to the earth itself. I was as flabbergasted as anyone else when the planet made a shift noticeable enough for scientists to calculate. It is possible this time as I study and look for a physical application to our planet, that the Lord will exercise a spiritual shift in the Body of Christ instead of a physical one to the planet. I simply do not know.

Secondly, I am **not** of the opinion that Jesus is coming back on April 23, 2018. Our Lord made it crystal clear that **no man knows the day or the hour for the return of the Son of man** (Matthew 24:36-44; Mark 13:32; 1 Thessalonians 5:1-3; 2 Peter 3:10; Revelation 3:3). I am repeating all this again because it came to my attention recently that some misguided person is telling everyone that Jesus will return on 4/23/18. I say this individual is misguided simply because the Bible’s language on this matter is not cloudy nor hard to understand, as you can read from the Scripture references I just made. We are told to be ready for His return at any time, like the five wise virgins who had their lamps ready with oil and properly trimmed, waiting for His return (Matthew 25:1-13). In fact, this passage of Scripture is more appropriate for our discussion here. Why must our Lord use *Gauntlet* people to shift and awaken everyone else? Simply because many in the Body of Christ today are like the five unwise virgins in Matthew 25:1-13, who fell asleep and did not keep their lamps full of oil and their wicks trimmed.

So with those caveats out of the way, let’s look at the second part of updated editions of three articles published on our ministry’s website from January to

March of 2003. As mentioned in the first part, some of what I will share will not be immediate events or events that everyone will experience. While that might be the case, all believers in Christ have the potential to become world changers. God is looking to shape the character and lives of many believers in order to usher in waves of various kinds of revivals. Some will be revivals focused on individual salvation, some healing revivals, others will be revivals surrounding a renewed study of theology— and not any old dry, warn-out study— but one which will see signs and wonders directly relating to biblical patterns experienced by the early church, only updated and relevant for a new millennia. We may even see revivals or renewals which entail combinations of all of the above.

If you haven't already, I encourage you to take a look at our archive's page on this site and click on the last archived article. Let me review some of what was shared in our last article. A word had been brewing in me recently, but I didn't realize it was the same or similar word the Lord spoke to me in 2002. Those words were published on our ministry's site and preached in 2003. That's when I realized the Lord was getting ready to bring the Body of Christ through another shift or change.

If you will look at the archive for the articles on this site for 2017, you will see that July's article shares some of the struggles those with various addictions go through, and December's article looks at various character traits those who are raised up as warriors in the Lord have. I felt as if our Lord was letting me know He is taking the addicts, the destitute and those who this world has "thrown away," cleaning them up, while raising up those no one considers as "worthy." They will be turned into world changers and eventual leaders to bring about His plans and purposes.

Many will question why change is needed at all. I need to ask a question: Do we see the Body of Christ today— and when I say *Body of Christ*, I mean those who claim Christianity— as miracle-working, salvation machines? Wherever they place their feet, a revival of signs and wonders with souls saved follows? My answer to that question is no. Now, not everyone who claims Jesus has the same gifts and calling, but each one of us has far more than we are willing to function in right now. For those living in America, we are also in a place where a foreign entity is attempting to take over all of America. It is using both political parties, and unfortunately, has taken over

the DNC already. The RNC, along with many republican lawmakers are still holding out, but the democrats are 99 percent gone. It has already captured many of our institutions and has invaded the thinking of our school children, colleges, law schools and media.

We have millions in America who have no idea that in the last 100 years our country has been taken over by progressive socialists. This “hybrid” is as bad as communism itself. It is a scientific fact that socialism is actually communism’s mother.<sup>1</sup> In order to change from a united system to a system which inflicts conflict in order to control the populace, you must create division and chaos. This is socialism’s goal. Once that is accomplished, communism is the end result. Scientifically, it can be nothing else. This is why foreign entities need to do everything possible to use natural divisions which do exist, to inflict more chaos. This is how total control is manifested.

danger of losing the entire country.<sup>2</sup> Many feel lowering the voting age is a good thing. The problem with that is most teenagers in this country are refused education about how this nation was formed, about the science of socialism and where it will lead. This makes them patsies for only one party: Democrats, who have been totally captured.

Many adults, as well as those aged sixteen to twenty-something, simply do not know where the eventual scientific outcome of their politics will lead them. Some of that is due to their lack of historical knowledge of how this country and its laws formerly behaved and functioned. Some of it is due to political racism against Christians and Jews and the resultant system of laws we originally built. Others are handed out a constant barrage of how good it is to give people “free” stuff, never realizing that socialism is the best con and Ponzi scheme out there. As Christians we love to camp around the signs the Lord gives. Books are written about moons, stars and faraway planets. The reality is they are all signs created by the Almighty for one reason. The Bible says it is this: “The heavens declare the glory of

God” (Psalm 19:1-4). We have whole sciences dedicated to the signs the Lord gives in the heavens, but they never, or seldom ever, look to understand the glory of the One who made them. In our defense, we do serve a God who relishes giving the most outrageous of signs. After all, Jesus’ resurrection is our sign. It is the ultimate sign that Father God accepted Christ’s work as THE SACRIFICE for mankind. This God that we serve is so awesome, and His signs so stupendous, that humans just stare into the night sky, sometimes for a whole lifetime. But sometimes God does need to shake us into reality so we will not be shaken by someone else’s reality.

What shakes us controls us. If people shake you, you will never challenge people. So God shapes and molds a people so that nothing but His word shakes and moves them (Acts 17:28). While the signs are important to know “something” is coming, the timing God gives is important to know as well. In our last article, I shared in the footnotes how the Lord commanded me to give the original painting of this word to a nationally recognized minister (you clicked on a digital copy to read this article). I have not had contact with this ministry since then and have no idea if they still possess the painting. But when the Lord asked me to do that, it was during one of those church services where He also asked me to sow my watch into the offering as well. Frankly, I had no idea why at the time because I was just too annoyed that I had to donate my watch! It wasn’t until I got home and settled down a bit that I realized it didn’t matter to the Lord what watch was sown, just that it was also another sign of God’s timing. Once I thought about it, I was actually thankful that the Holy Spirit let me keep my other watch!

Humans, what a fickle bunch we are! As I said, it wasn’t until I started to think clearly that the Holy Spirit started to make me aware of His timing. As you read this next article from 2003, I want you to keep in mind this little bit of theology the Lord impressed me with in 2003, after I donated that watch. Recently, as I was reminded of this past experience and these articles, I recalled this theology as well. This theology is something Bible school students are taught, and it is something the Lord shares with many “prophets in training.” When we view prophetic timing in our Bibles as shared by prophets who foretold Messiah, the awesomeness of God is revealed. Many of these prophecies have timing requirements which fit into four categories: Initial, Anticipatory, Progressive and Final or cumulative.

For example, Isaiah 7:14: “Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.” I don’t have the space to delve into the fullness of this prophecy by looking at the passages before and after. I say that so you realize there is much more in timing, as well as other dynamics to this passage. Nevertheless, we see here a good example of what I am trying to convey. In order for Isaiah to be considered a true prophet, his word had to come to pass. In Isaiah 8, we see his wife, or his “virgin” conceive, giving birth to Isaiah’s son, approximately one year later. This is the initial fulfillment of Isaiah’s word. Some might balk at this assessment; but, the reality is that the word for *virgin* Isaiah uses does not automatically mean virgin. It is the Hebrew word *almah*, and it means a young women roughly between the ages of 13 to 21. For that period of time, this means if she were not married she **was a virgin**. While that is not necessarily true today, it was mandatory during Isaiah’s period of time.

So Isaiah’s *handmaiden* (the transliteration of the word *almah*) conceives and bares a son. By this act God accomplishes two birds with one stone, so to speak. Isaiah is now considered a true prophet and the initial category of this word is fulfilled. The next, or anticipatory time period is fulfilled when a real virgin, named Mary, some 700-plus years later conceives and bares a son— Jesus— Immanuel, God with us. The third or progressive time period is fulfilled as the virgin Bride of Christ— the church— conceives and reproduces sons to God through the Holy Spirit by sharing the salvation message. The final or cumulative time period fulfillment of this word is as the Body of Christ— the whole church (Jew and Gentile) invite Jesus back to the earth and they then conceive Christ on the earth and God wraps this whole thing up (Ephesians 2:11-16; see the whole book of Revelation).

There aren’t too many Christian theologies out there which disagree with this as a theological lesson. So keep this timing theology in mind as you read the Scripture verses we review at the end of this article from 2003. As I did in our previous article, I will use blue ink to differentiate between now and 2003. There were some minor changes made for modern grammar and ease of reading. Otherwise, this article is exactly as it appeared in 2003.

Part Two  
God, His Gauntlet, The Switch and Our Shift

Last month we reviewed the foundation for the circumstances we see played out as God uses a people group to accomplish His set of plans and circumstances. As we discussed some things about God last month, and looked at some of His previous ‘gauntlet’ people, three questions arose. In a nutshell, these questions ask whether or not it is possible for *Gauntlet* people to be in rebellion and strife. How can they be sensitive enough to the Holy Spirit to know if they are; and, are there any dynamics to let God’s people know when God is getting ready to do this?

I see God raising up a group of people that are willing to go through some ‘stuff’ in order to see Christ exalted. As a result, they challenge mediocre Christianity and the world as well. They can be labeled as weird or possibly even rebellious by their Christian brothers and sisters. These saints are going to be willing to spend their ‘all’ for Jesus. Since this is not the ‘norm’ for a large group of those in western Christianity today, a transition will be evident as God requires many to lay down more and more of their possessions and positions in both the world and the ‘church’ world. Since this is a transition, for some it may be as simple as giving up some time in ways they never did before. For others, it may mean saying no to that important job offer because Jesus told them to come and follow Him. And for others, it may mean giving up their coveted positions in religion, while risking ridicule to do what our Lord has required them to do. For all of us, it will mean a daily desire to go to the cross in our lives.

This is why our first question concerning rebellion is so important. As I read the Scriptures and look at the lives of those who seem equipped with this call, I see five different trials Father God will take them through to test their faith, obedience and motives. These are five tests Jesus went through. They are five tests the early church experienced. What these five tests will produce is a people who come in total agreement with the Word of the Lord on the face of the earth. Jesus came in total agreement with God’s word on earth. The disciples, Rome and the Jewish priests did not come in total agreement with God’s word concerning Messiah. Because the disciples’ heart was to believe, as well as some Romans (centurion), Jewish priests and leaders (Nicodemus), our Lord challenged them to believe and follow Him totally. As a result, they also became ‘gauntlet’ people who challenged religious norms within their own spheres of influence.

There are definite life experiences God will take such people through to prepare them for this walk. The first is obvious; it is childhood education. If one is raised without discipline or is raised in an environment of abusive discipline, God will have to rearrange our upbringing to line up with His discipline. If they are raised without a hard work ethic (the word couch potato comes to mind), God will put them in years of a hard work environment to change them. People like Nicodemus and the disciples were well trained in the Scriptures and hard work at very early ages. So God may have to take some today through many, many years of Biblical training as well as hard labor. Much of this training will surround their character. These five tests or circumstances are experiences that expose any and all areas of rebellion.

While Jesus had no areas of rebellion to be exposed, He still walked through these tests: **One**, He allowed His feelings to be hurt (see Matthew 23:37, John 11:35). **Two**, He allowed Himself to be exposed no matter the consequences (see John 10:25-39). **Three**, even though He was right in His assessment of situations, He never flaunted it (see John 19:10, 11). If I were talking about a mere mortal I would explain this circumstance this way: Gauntlet people swallow their pride, even *if* they're right. **Number four**, He allowed Himself to be wronged and falsely accused (see Luke 22:37). **And last, but definitely not least**, He allowed Himself to be tested by Father God in these as well as many other areas with no outward sign of approval from God that He passed the test and no approval from friends, family, religious or governmental leaders around Him (see Isaiah 53:3, 4).

Even if you have read the Gospels through once, I think you will agree that we see these same patterns over and over again. If we apply our present world troubles to these circumstances, we can see that if everyone allowed Jesus to take them through these five areas, there would be no wars and no rumors of wars. These areas are hard to be tested in. But after a while, it almost becomes easy. You might say, how do you know that you're in one of His tests? My answer: say something — go ahead, open your mouth. You'll know. I've learned that if I'm in one of His tests, the more I say will only make it worse.

When you're walking with God through one of these tests, you will learn how to love people, even when you know you don't want to love them. Jesus loved us while we were still His enemies (see Romans 5:8). Love is not a feeling. Love is a choice. I wish love were just a feeling, then this would be easy. Because *Gauntlet* people are going to be used by God to challenge some things, their motive can be nothing other than God's motives. In fact, I doubt very much that they know how much of an impact they have made until some time later (except in the case of

Jesus). This is how one will know that they can be sensitive enough to hear the Holy Spirit in these situations: they still love.

In an attitude of love you can hear Jesus say anything He wants you to know. A mistake concerning these tests is to expect everyone to be on the same level. This simply is not fair. What God may require of me as a test is not the same experience He may require of someone else. A test for a young mother with children or a grandmother may be to open their home to people making a mess of it in, let's say for example, a Bible study. While a test for a young, single man may be to go off to war. These two tests couldn't be more different in their experiences, yet Jesus can be just as pleased with the grandmother as the young soldier. They all were tested in their obedience, faith and love and in the end bitterness and non-forgiveness never controlled their hearts. They loved the unlovely just like Jesus did.

Now that we have discussed our first two questions, we have one last question remaining. Are there any dynamics or patterns we see evidenced that will let us know God is "Taking off the gloves" and throwing down a gauntlet? There are four Scripture verses I felt led to read. They are: Deuteronomy 29:4; Psalm 115:7 and Psalm 135:16 & 17 read as one reference together; Isaiah 6:9, and finally, Matthew 13:15.

You might read these and say, they all say the same thing: People seem to be hearing, but not understanding, and they seem to be seeing, but not perceiving. Yes, they do all say that, but they aren't all the same. But that is the indicator that we see before God takes off those gloves. Each portion of Scripture was written during a different time period in Israel's history. In Deuteronomy we see the first part of the book with God recalling His people's past, while the next portion of the book envisions Israel's future life in this new land. From chapter 29 to 30, with the exception of some texts concerning the wilderness, God now places their possible future before them if they heed his warnings. The choice is theirs. They are a 'new' people, having had the brokenness of slavery stripped off of them. What will their choice be? Will they receive eyes to see and ears to hear? Or will they go back to their old ways and circumvent this new eyesight and spiritual hearing?

This is important; because, it is at just such a place in all new believers' lives when satan tries to persuade them to turn back from following Christ. It is at just such a place in a newness of Christian experience in a seasoned believer's life, that satan will tempt them to return to the old, nominal Christianity. You may have experienced a spiritual awakening of some kind from visiting a church, or just a newness of a walk in your prayer life, and some well meaning friend will come

along and say, “It doesn’t take all that to please Jesus. You don’t have to wake up so early in the morning and fast all those days. You don’t have to put yourself or your family out like that.”

At that point, you are just developing new eyes to see Jesus with and new ears to hear Him. If you listen to these voices— mark my words— you will lose your new eyesight and hearing. I’m not saying repentance won’t restore you. But that’s part of satan’s attack plan. When you fall back, you may not even have the spiritual eyesight or hearing to know you need to repent. In Israel’s case, God, so to speak, ‘threw down’ Joshua and Caleb (*gauntlet* people), as examples of proper leadership and proper ‘hearing and seeing’ responses to God and His Word. And so our Lord may send a preacher, a book, an article, our private Bible reading time or a different friend to challenge us right back to His path of proper eyesight and hearing.

Psalms 115 and 135 are interesting Psalms. Historically, they were probably written at different times. The bulk of scholars place Psalm 115 within the time period of the Second Temple building revival; and Psalm 135, as possibly being written much earlier by Hezekiah during that Temple revival. Whether that is true or not, one thing is certain: These were written by a people who are spiritually on fire for God.

Both these psalms are hymns used in Temple worship. In fact, after the Passover supper finished with the fourth cup, the second portion of the Hallel— Psalms 113-118 of which Psalms 115-118 were the second part— would have been sung. This is the reference Matthew makes when he says, “When they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives” (Matthew 26:30). It is not always during times of backsliding when satan comes to tempt a people, but when they are on the mountain top with God. When you are feeling your strongest in Christ and all is going well, you have to remind yourself how easy it is to serve an idol in your heart.

Maybe your idol is not a carving of Buddha or some other icon. Maybe your idol is comfort and a nice car. Maybe God has given you these. Maybe you belong to a church that is on fire for God. Maybe you get caught up in working hard in that church but ever so subtly in your heart you judge another’s work as not work enough or another’s service as not as important as yours. It won’t take long for other areas of judgment to creep in. Before you know it, your idols have become your own thoughts. God is never able to do anything that challenges you in front of anybody else. All the while, even in the midst of spiritual renewal, you can develop

ears that won't hear and eyes which refuse to spiritually see. This is how new moves of God become persecuted by the old move of God. This is how this spiritual pattern keeps playing out in history and in revival after revival. In fact, in my opinion, this is why I think God raises up a new movement, as a 'gauntlet' people to challenge the old movement. Thank God He does. It is His kindness showing the old movement that He alone is God. No work or program or new thing moves Him. He alone moves us (Acts 17:28). He alone does the work that turns the earth (Psalm 135:6).

Isaiah 6:9 would seem to portray the same example as the previous Psalms. But a closer look at who God was sending Isaiah to would change that understanding. This is Israel pre-exile. What encouraged that exile along is what Isaiah was sent to warn them about. They will refuse to listen, developing the same hardness of hearing their hymns have warned them about. This category of people are falling in line with God's promise to them from Deuteronomy 30. They are about to be a banished people. They have no idea that their sin will exile them because their ears are stopped up and they have developed spiritual blindness. Isaiah and many of the subsequent prophets (see Jeremiah 5:21, Ezekiel 12:2, Zechariah 7:7-12) are 'thrown down' as *Gauntlet* people to warn their brethren of their complacency and blindness. Because they refuse to listen, this turns events toward exile. While in exile, they repent and believe. Their ears are opened and their eyes see. They now see the fulfillment of Deuteronomy 30:1-6, and they are restored.

I have seen folks who have had a relationship with Jesus and the Holy Spirit and then turn back. It is almost as if there are blinders on their eyes. They simply will not and cannot see that their course of action will take them farther away from God, not closer. I've seen it take days, weeks, months and years (on some, I'm still waiting) for them to want a relationship with the Holy Spirit again. Sometimes a jolt from reality, or even a time of severe hardship woke them up. It should not surprise us that saved and Holy Spirit-filled people should turn back from following their God. We can be thankful that Deuteronomy 30 was written. We should be thankful that the story of the prodigal son was told to us. Whatever our experience with backsliding, we can all be thankful we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ, the Son (1 John 2:1). We can remember that Ecclesiastes 7:20 (see also 1 John 1:8-10), pertains to all those who claim Christ as their own—and we can thank God for 1 John 1:9.

The last Scripture, Matthew 13:15, is written to a twice-pardoned people who are on their way to ruin. As a group they're putting up a good front. But deep inside they know that they're lost. This is why, for the most part, the common man

followed Christ as Messiah and why, for the most part, their religious leadership did not believe He was who He said He was. Jesus was a ‘gauntlet’ person used by God to challenge their natural laws (see Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 1:25, Mark 10:51,52), their theology (see John 10:30), as well as their understanding of Roman rule and Messiah (see John 7:32-52). He is sent not only as Isaiah was sent to jolt them back to God’s reality, but to change every aspect of how they functioned and perceived themselves in relationship to ‘their’ world. This is why there is a constant command to have ears that hear all throughout the gospels (see Mark 4:23, 7:12; Luke 8:8, 14:35). It is also why there was the same constant command made by the apostles throughout the rest of the early church’s history (see Acts 28:26,27; Romans 11:8). And, it is why Jesus makes the final command in the book of Revelation for him who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches (see Revelation 3:22).

It seems the condition of having ears which don’t hear and eyes that don’t see is not just relegated to the Old Testament. It is a condition prevalent in our society today, both in religious circles and secular ones. Any time we have been forgiven and set free, we can stand at the door of this condition. As Christians we cannot deny it as a possibility. As Christians if we say God cannot perform a miracle, He will mess with our understanding of ‘natural’ law. If we say God cannot be in such and such a situation, He will mess with our theology. If we say He must come back a certain way— watch it— He just may come back the way which suits Him, yet still fulfills all Scripture. If He tries to show us our error and change our hearts, but we refuse— watch it. We have just crossed the doorway of this condition. And unless God continues to jolt us, we will have spiritually deaf ears and spiritually blinded eyes. These are four historical patterns which let us know God is getting ready to ‘take off the gloves’ and send our world changing. As we look around us we can see how close we are to this happening. When we view this word from 2003, along with what we know the Lord has done and what He is telling us He is getting ready to do, there are many parallels we can draw from in order to see God raising up a new group of people to challenge, as well as help take the earth into a new phase which will bring us in line with our Lord’s timing for the planet. As I look at the research concerning the earth’s shifting poles— like I wrote at the beginning — I am not of the doom and gloom group which has the sky falling around us. Past evidence of these pole shifts on our planet do not reveal that type of

scenario.<sup>3</sup> What the research has revealed is that continents do not shift off the globe. Instead, it is a more gradual occurrence. More like magnetic wobbles. Continents remain where they are, only magnetic fields move.

This “hobby” of mine in researching such things, along with the Lord’s word of a “Shift” is nothing more than a sign. Like most signs from the Almighty, they are pretty spectacular. The last time I received this word, it was roughly two years after that the earth “shifted” or wobbled in a discernible way. When our Lord gives us a sign, it is nothing more than a heads-up to tell us to get ready. Signs don’t exist because we are so successful. Signs exist so we don’t blow it. God also gives us signs so we have time and space to get ready for when He moves. My question is, “Will we move with the Lamb?
