West District Commissioner, Kyle White, East District Commissioner Chet Owen and County Clerk Melissa Meek.
Absent Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll.

East District Commissioner, Chet Owen, opened the meeting with a prayer & led all those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve the agenda for today's meeting and the minutes from the March 24th meeting. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen seconded the motion. Motion carried.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek presented the TAN (Tax Anticipation Note) with Independent Farmer's Bank for the 2 vehicles belonging to the Sheriff's Office. This note will be renewed with \$14,082.41 being paid for each vehicle. That includes \$4082.41 in interest & \$10,000.00 applied to the principal. Loan will be renewed with the same process in 2027 until the loan is paid in full West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve the TAN (Tax Anticipation Note) with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor, White-aye, Owen-aye and Carroll-absent. Motion carried 2-0.

East District Commissioner, Chet Owen reported that he had attended a CAP meeting.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White, will attend a Tri-County Health meeting on this day.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White advised that he had talked to the State Fire Marshall concerning a burn ban. DeKalb County doesn't meet the criteria. At this time the DeKalb County Commission is asking that patrons refrain from any kind of burning until we receive rainfall.

A patron from Washington Township met with the Commission to discuss an issue with a culvert on Orchard Rd. Road & Bridge Supervisor Bill Gray will go & see what is needed to fix the patrons concern & get with the Township if that is what is needed.

Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gray discussed work around the County, equipment & BRO projects.

The Commission reviewed & approved accounts payable & accounts receivable.

DeKalb County Clerk, Melissa Meek reminded everyone that April 7th was the General Municipal Election. She had received several calls concerning the poorly written ballot issue. She wanted to make sure everyone understood the issue so when asked they could explain. Most importantly explain that it is in litigation at this time & that has nothing to do with the Senior Tax Credit.
