1. Selectmen Meeting was called to order approximately at 6:30 PM by Jim Dolloff.

2. Review/ Approve minutes

Gerry Brown requested a motion to accept and approve June 2nd, 2020 minutes. Dwight Warren seconded the motion; no discussion. Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve the minutes.

3. Review/ Approve warrant

Gerry Brown requested a motion to accept and approve June 16th, 2020 warrant. Dwight Warren seconded the motion; no discussion. Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve the warrant.

New Business

- <u>Tree growth application</u>: Selectmen reviewed tree growth application, voted 3-0 to approve and signed.
- Ben Thompson Open Space Application: Open space application from Francis Small Heritage Trust Inc was reviewed and discussed. Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve and sign the open space application.
- Review cemetery rules: There is a hole in the new cemetery. Need to find owner of the lot and contact to find out the status of the hole.
- <u>Lawnmower issues</u>: The lawnmower is broken and Brian having a hard time getting parts. Need to check in with Brian and possibly look for another way to cut the lawn by hiring someone. Jo Pierce volunteered to bush hog.
- Review Case 2017-06 taxes: Family of the resident contacted the office with regards to back taxes. Would like to discuss with Selectmen how best to pay back taxes and if they can regain the property. Selectmen will discuss with the family during the next workshop, family to be contacted.
- Spirit of America 2020 nominee: A few names were mentioned. Will discuss further during Selectmen workshop.
- <u>2020/2021 Fuel Bid</u>: Selectmen discussed and will publish fuel bid ad next week in Shopping Guide.
- <u>Janitorial Hours</u>: Randy is retired and inquired about getting more hours at Community Center to clean. Will discus more with Randy on Saturday.
- <u>Jason Brown Fire Department repairs</u>: Jason Brown discussed the need to repair West Baldwin Fire Station and also researching the location for a central fire station. His concern was repairing a station that needs a lot of repairs and could be costly.
