

WHAT

IDPA is the use of practical equipment including full charge service ammunition to solve simulated real world self-defense scenarios using practical handguns and holsters that are suitable for self-defense use. The main goal is to test the skill and ability of an individual.

REGISTRATION

Matches will be done in a "shoot and scoot" format, meaning you can show up anytime, get registered at the range desk, and then go into the bays and shoot whatever stage you'd like.

\$20/shooter. Shooters may shoot a second time for an additional \$10.

Since this is "Shoot and Scoot" style, there will not be any practiscore pre-registration for the match.

WHEN

Matches will be held on the following Wednesday nights:

The schedule of each match is as follows.

4:00pm	Setup
4:30pm	Registration Opens
5:00pm	Start Shooting
8:00pm	Registration Closes
9:00pm	(or earlier) Teardown

New shooters are required to attend orientation at 6:00pm before shooting.

STAGES

Each match will have 2 stages. Each string of fire will be 18 rounds or less, but stages may have up to 25 rounds minimum in them.

Accordingly to IDPA rules, you may only have 2 (or 3 for BUG/REV) magazines on your belt, but it is recommended you come to the firing line with 1-3 extra magazines in your pockets, especially for those of you shooting CCP/BUG/REV.

This may seem cumbersome, but it will allow shooters to maximize trigger time and minimize overall total time invested.

STAFFING

Each bay will have a Chief Safety Officer (CSO) assigned to it, rotating out on shifts throughout the night. If you are an IDPA Safety Officer interested in taking a shift as CSO in exchange for a waived entry fee, please contact me.

Note that we will also need and appreciate help from other IDPA Safety Officers and the community to help setup, teardown, score, and paste targets.
