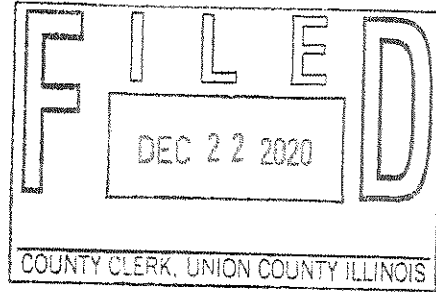

**ORDINANCE NO. 2020-05**

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR THE CITY OF JONESBORO, UNION COUNTY, ILLINOIS, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 2020, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2021, AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE ILLINOIS TRUTH-IN-TAXATION ACT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, UNION COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1. GENERAL CORPORATE PURPOSES**

The following sums of money, or as therefrom as may be authorized by law, are hereby ascertained as the total amount of the Annual Budget legally made, passed and adopted on May 18, 2020, as Ordinance No. 2020-02, which funds are to be provided for and from the annual tax levy for the fiscal year, beginning on May 1, 2020 and ending on April 30, 2021:

**SECTION 2.** The Aggregate Levy is not more than 105% of the amount which was Extended on behalf of the City for the preceding year, and the Levy and this Ordinance are in compliance with the requirements of the Truth-In-Taxation Act.

**SECTION 3.** This Annual Tax Levy Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

**SECTION 4.** The City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this Ordinance to be filed with the Clerk of Union County, Illinois, on or before the last Tuesday in December of this year.

**SECTION 5.** The Mayor and City Clerk, with the advice and consent of their legal advisor, shall have the power and authority to alter and/or modify said levies, on or prior to their actual extension by the Union County Clerk, for purposes of complying or conforming with the laws of the State of Illinois.
