Emma Reck, 94 of St. Joseph, who taught in Sebewaing from 1922 - 1927, died in a nursing home in St. Joseph on Tuesday, Oct. 26.

A native of Bridgman, she studied parochial school teaching in Milwaukee, and came to Sebewaing in the fall of 1922. She taught first grade at Immanuel Lutheran School from then until 1927 when she accepted a similar position in St. Joseph. Miss Reck was never married.

A funeral service was held in St. Joseph at 1:30 p.m. Friday, Oct. 29.

While teaching in Sebewaing, in the tradition of teachers in those years, she rented a room and lived with local families, including the late Charles and Anna Hahn on S. Center Street, and their son-in-law and daughter, the late Theodore and Aldine Juengel on Grove Street.
