

ORDINANCE 2017-12

Commercial/ Resident Pool Draining

Whereas: It has been determine that pool water was discharged into the Sanitary Sewer and a strong smelled of Chlorine at the Waste Water Plant was noted.

Whereas: When the testing was done at the plant the numbers came back that high amount of Chlorine was in the system. Draining large amounts of chlorinated water will eliminate the good bacteria that is needed for the wastewater plant to operate correctly and will result in high costs to the Town of Cloverdale to reverse the effects of the excess chlorine.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of Cloverdale, Putnam County, State of Indiana that a fine of \$250.00 (two hundred fifty dollar) be imposed for owners of pools that are being drained into the sanitary sewers without prior approval (written notice 48 hours or 2 working days before discharge).

If a need to replace the bacteria that was destroyed by the chlorinated pool water without prior knowledge than the violator **shall** paid in full to purchase the good bacteria. Which could cost up to \$50,000.00 (fifty thousand dollars). Civil penalties may be imposed.
