Find the answers to your questions regarding the selection process below:

- 1. How are students selected? Via the application process which includes an interview with the committee
- 2. Are DAASF scholarships based on merit or financial need? Scholarships are based on a variety of standards applied to a rubric
- 3. I do not come from a low-income family. Do I have a chance to receive a scholarship? If the standards of the process are met one will be considered
- 4. Can I apply for more than one scholarship? **DAASF only offers one** scholarship
- 5. I have a really high GPA and consider myself a strong candidate. Why didn't I receive a scholarship? **This depends on each individual applicant**
- 6. I have been selected, and am, or will be, enrolled at more than one institution to make me full-time; am I still eligible for the scholarship? **DAASF** considers full time enrollment at only one institution
- 7. I have been selected and I applied for multiple scholarships. Can I wait to see if I can get a higher award amount? Applicants may apply for any all scholarships they desire.
