Hello/Hi = Salut (sah-loo)

Good Morning/Good Day = Bonjour (bon-zhoor)

Good Evening = Bonsoir (bon-swahr)

Good Night = Bonne nuit (bonn nwee)

Goodbye = Au revoir (oh ruh-vwar)

Please = S'il vous plait (see voo play)

Thank you (very much) = Merci (beaucoup) (Mair-see)

Excuse Me (asking for something) = Excusez-moi (ex-kew-zay mwah)

Excuse Me (to pass by) = Pardon (pahr-dohn)

I'm Sorry = Je suis désolé (zhuh swee de-sol-eh)

Yes/ No = Oui/ Non (wee/nohn)

One = un (ahn)

Two = deux (duh)

Three = trois (twah)

Four = quatre (cat)

Five = cinq (sank)

Six = six (seese)

Seven = sept (set)

Eight = huit (wheat)

Nine = neuf (nuhf)

Ten = dix (deese)
