RSAI Legislative Priority Development: Thanks to RSAI members who filled out the legislative issues survey, which informed the RSAI Legislative Committee at their meeting on Aug. 13, to prepare a draft platform. The Committee also reviewed the notes of discussions at the spring RSAI Regional Meetings, where each region set priorities and discussed issues. The Committee's recommendations will be reviewed by the Leadership Group at the September meeting, then posted on the RSAI Annual Meeting webpage and distributed to all RSAI members before the Annual Meeting, on Oct. 15th at the FFA Enrichment Center on the DMACC campus in Ankeny, beginning at 4:30pm.
