The **Immediate Care Center: the Doctor is IN** is happy to announce that **Julie DeRosa, MD**, has been certified in November 2011 by the American Association of Medical Review Officers (AAMRO) as a “Medial Review Officer” meeting the federal requirements as established in 2001 for federally related drug testing programs for employee and occupational health. The Immediate Care Center provides employee and occupational health services for employers in NW Indiana at its location on US Hwy 30 & Burr Street from 7 AM to 10 PM seven days a week, no appointment needed.

AAMRO, created in 1991, is a non-profit medical society dedicated to establishing national standards and certification of medical practitioners in the field of alcohol and drug testing. This certification process involves the establishment of standard practices, procedures and training programs, and the administration of certification exams.

AAMRO certification is intended to be the standard of quality service and ethical conduct by qualified professionals involved in drug and alcohol testing.

The Immediate Care Center was recognized earlier this year as Indiana’s second Certified Urgent Care Center by the Urgent Care Association of America and provides pediatric, medical and minor trauma services to all ages of patients. The ICC accepts most major insurance and credit cards. The ICC has been featured in letters sent by Anthem and other health insurers as an efficient and cost effective site for health problems that do not require the full service of an ER.
