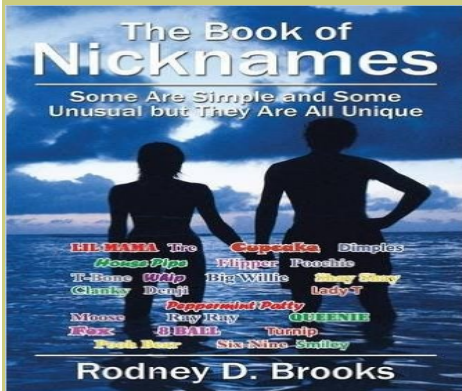


The Book of Nicknames

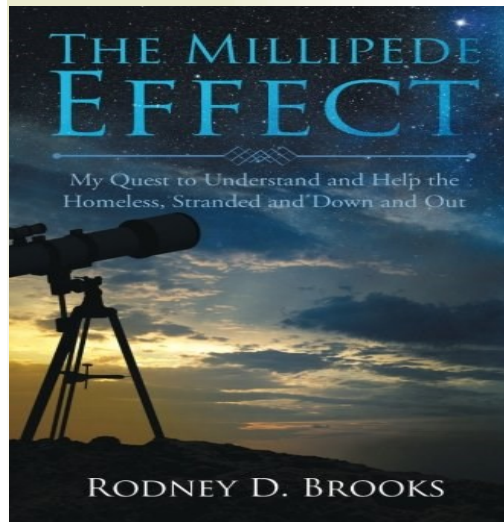

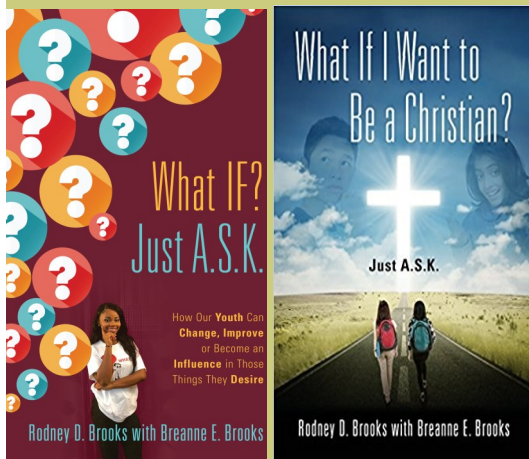

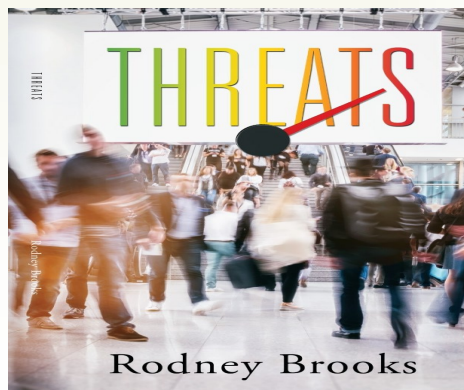
