



Haunted History Tour FAQ's - Fall 2018

1. **Where do we get on our Haunted History Tour?** Please meet us at the Zephyr Theater at 601 Main Street North in Stillwater, MN 55082. This will be headquarters for our tours this year. There is plenty of seating inside and the tours start and end here.
2. **Where do we park?** There is parking at the Zephyr Theater and there is also a parking lot next door, across from the Warden's House listed as Lot 12 on the [Stillwater Parking Map](#).
3. **How scary is the event?** We would love to scare the dickens out of everyone, but we recommend ages 12 and older. You will need to be able to sit on the trolley for 60 -70 minutes and there are no child seats. There will actors dressed as historic characters that can be scary for some children. The subject matter of these historic stories can be gruesome or contain some graphic details.
4. **What tour times are available?** There will be a 7:00, 7:30, 8:30, and 9pm tour and plan for about 90 minutes to board the trolley, enjoy the tour, and get back to the Zephyr Theater again. If one time is sold out, check the website occasionally as people may cancel or change their tour time.
5. **Where are my tickets?** You will receive an email confirmation after booking your tour online. Ensure the date and time is correct. This is a ticketless event, just check in when you arrive that night. Easy, peasy! You will receive you and/or your group's beverage token(s) at that time too.
6. **What beverages are included in my tour registration?** When you check in on the night of your performance, you will be given a token that can be used at the Zephyr Theater for one FREE glass of wine, beer, or a soda. There is also water and punch available. You can also purchase additional beer and wine at the Zephyr Theater too, but please do not bring them on the trolley tour.
7. **What is your refund policy?** If you need to cancel, please let us know one week prior to your tour to receive a 100% refund. No refunds will be allowed with less than a 7 day notice. You can also transfer your tickets to a friend, but please email us at kerri@mywahoadventures.com or call Kerri at 651.280.7299 so we can make that change.

8. **Is the trolley accessible for people with disabilities?** Yes, the 7:00pm and 8:30pm performances are wheelchair accessible. Please [email us](#) if you will be bringing a wheelchair as we have limited space and want to accommodate as many guests as possible.
9. **How should I dress for my Haunted Tour?** The trolleys are heated but the doors will be open and shut frequently. October temperatures vary, so we recommend you dress in layers, so you will be ready for fall temperatures. Of course we welcome those who want to get into the “spirit” and come costumed as well.
10. **Rain or Dark?** The Haunted History Tours will be held rain or of course dark. In fact, a rainy tour may be the perfect backdrop for our gruesome stories!
11. **I’ve taken the tour, now I’m starving, what are my options?** We encourage you to come early or stay late and enjoy other fun restaurants and venues in Stillwater. Check out [Discover Stillwater](#) to plan your evening. We hope to have a food truck available and will post on Facebook once one is confirmed.
12. **Fright or Flight?** The Haunted Trolley Tour is scary, but mostly ALL fun. Please be respectful to your fellow trolley riders. No alcoholic beverages on the trolley. We reserve the right to remove any boy or ghoulish who interferes with everyone else’s enjoyment.
13. This bullet is only here because we had to include the feared and haunted number of all times - **#13!!**

Don’t miss the tour – please plan to arrive 30 minutes early. This gives you time to check in, enjoy your free beverage, enjoy some food, and take a potty break before your trolley departs.
