WHILE AN ATTEMPT HAS BEEN MADE TO DOCUMENT PERTINENT POINTS, THESE MINUTES CONTAIN ONLY A SUMMARY OF THE DISCUSSION AND VOTING. 9 Mayor Carrie Roecks called the meeting to order at 7:00pm with the Pledge of Allegiance. 10 11 Roll call took place. Those present were Mayor Carrie Roecks, Councilmembers Clint Stevenson, Micki 12 Harnois, Tim Fricke, William Benson, Brian Laude, Clerk/Treasurer Heidi Johnson and Public Works' 13 Dave Thompson. 14 15 Ms. Harnois made a motion to approve the amended agenda. Mr. Stevenson seconded the motion. 16 Motion was carried. 17 18 Mr. Benson made a motion to approve the minutes from the 07/05/2018 public hearing and regular 19 meeting. Mr. Fricke seconded the motion. Motion was carried. 20 21 ANNOUNCEMENTS 22 - July 23rd, 6pm, - Council has scheduled a workshop to review and edit the town's current zoning 23 regulations. 24 - The Fire Chief has ordered a burn ban in town limits. No burning or recreational fires of any kind. 25 - Ms. Roecks told council that her house was not broken into, despite rumors that it was. 26 - Ms. Harnois reminded Council that there is a Council of Governments meeting at the Spokane Fairgrounds 27 on Friday, September 7th. Mrs. Johnson forwarded the councilmember the invitation email. 28 29 LAYNE MERRITT, JUB ENGINEERS 30 Mr. Merritt told Council that he spoke with the town's contact for the Community Development Block Grant 31 program regarding the funds that were awarded for the Emma Street Sewer project. Mr. Merritt said that the 32 bid opening for the project will be 08/09/2018, and hopefully there will be information for council by the first 33 regular September Council meeting. 34 35 Mr. Merritt passed out a proposed Agreement for Professional Services that included a Facility Plan 36 Amendment that addresses changes in Design Flow Criteria at the lagoons. The EPA requires this update 37 for the town to keep their discharge (NPDES) permit. 38 Ms. Harnois made a motion to approve the amended Agreement for Professional Services with JUB 39 Engineers. Mr. Laude seconded the motion. Motion was carried. 40 41 Mr. Merritt explained that he has been working with Mr. Thompson on the environmental process with the 42 Emma Street sewer project. Because the process required more time and paperwork than Mr. Thompson 43 was comfortable with doing on his own, JUB was asked to step in and finalize this portion of the project. The 44 total amount owed to JUB is now an additional \$2000.00 more than originally estimated. 45 Mr. Fricke made a motion to approve the payment of the additional charges. Mr. Stevenson seconded the motion. Motion was carried. 46 47 48 COUNCIL REPORTS 49 Ms. Harnois told Council to anticipate adopting a new ordinance for business licensing by January 1<sup>st</sup>.
