Congregate Meals: A hot lunch served at the Pickaway Senior Center at 11:30 AM on Monday, and at 12:00 noon Tuesday

through Friday.

Homemakers: Assistance with cleaning, laundry and running errands. Clients must meet certain eligibility criteria.

Meals on Wheels: A hot lunch delivered to your home five days a week.

National Family Caregiver Support Program:

Respite and personal care, financial help with co-pays and medicine, utility bills, home repair. The care recipient must be over 60 years of age.

Supportive Services: Assistance with Medicare & Medicaid papers, HEAP and Commodities paperwork.

Transportation:
Transportation for medical appointments, dialysis, and grocery shopping.
