

TOWN OF LINCOLN
SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING
April 5, 2025

The meeting was called to order by Jason Headson at 9:00 am. Present were: Jason Headson and Tressa Votis. Ryan Wilson and Lynne Black via phone call.

On a motion by Black, second by Wilson and all in favor, the agenda for the meeting was approved.

Tressa and Jason drove some roads within the Town to assess the tree/debris/brush situation. Jason stated that Tee Hines (using Todd Mihalko's processor) has cleared hazardous and low hanging trees from the majority of residential roads. He also stated that back roads such as **Johnson, Spring Pond**, etc. haven't been accessible and are currently blocked.

Roads travelled: **Northview/Southview (extreme debris along road)**, **W. Shore**, **Potawatomi Trail**, **Quade**, **Pine**, **Neal**, **Star Lake (still completely blocked)**, **Keith Siding**, **Schalk**, **Swamp Creek**, **Devil's Lake**, **Fire Tower**, **Bradley Lake**, **Wilson-Bessette/McKeague/Keepers**, **Mullins**, **Seils**, **Gretzinger**, **Corning**, **Lundt**, **Hemlock Lake area**, **Airport Road**, **Smith**, **Sportsman**, **Nemec**, **Timber**, **Strawberry Bluff**, **Range Line/Pence (yellow due to Pines)**

RED-impassable

YELLOW—needs professional brushing ,

GREEN-cleared, town can handle brush

The Town will meet on Monday night at 4:30 PM to look at quotes and options for chipping, debris removal and road clearing for impassable roads.
