

The August 4, 2020 meeting of St. Albans Township was called to order by Chairman, Randal Almendinger.

All trustees and fiscal officer are present.

This meeting is being held via tele-conference.

The July meeting minutes were read and approved as read.

The Fiscal Officer read fund balances to date.

Bruce Lane said road men have been ditching and some residents have been complaining. Bruce said the ditching needed to be done but they haven't been able to get to it for a few years so people are complaining about the mess.

Mike Theisen gave the July fire and EMS reports.

Mike and the trustees and fiscal officer discussed SB 310 in regards to funding for COVID 19 expenses.

Mike stated that he was just making trustees aware of it in case for future purposes if new mandates come out costing the department money, but stated as of now the costs have been minimal.

Trustees said they are going to hold off on applying for the money.

Bruce Lane said he has had 3 meetings with the health dept at the new township building and has been to the health dept. 4 times. All seems to be in good shape and he will be pulling well and septic permits on Wednesday.

Randal Almendinger said he and Chief Theisen had a meeting with the family with whom the medic had a fender bender with at the Hawks Nest last month and we will be paying their deductible.

Bruce Lane said he talked to Ryan Hutchinson about repairing the gutters and fascia on the fire station.

Trash bids were opened and read, 2 were received: Waste Management and Waste Away.

Randal Almendinger made a motion to switch to Waste Away for a 3 year agreement starting September 1, 2020 for \$13.95/ month for residential, \$12.50/ month for senior citizen and \$3.00/month for an optional toter.

2nd by Jean Morrison. Roll call: Jean Morrison –yes, Bruce Lane –yes, Randal Almendinger – yes. Motion carried.
