1. Toby fills each of his 4 bird feeders with $2\frac{1}{8}$ cups of birdseed. He fills each of his 3 hummingbird feeders with $1\frac{3}{4}$ cups of sugar water. How many more cups of birdseed does Toby use than sugar water?

2. Sasha makes bows for gifts. She uses 4 pieces of red ribbon that are each $1\frac{2}{3}$ feet long. She uses 6 pieces of blue ribbon that are each $2\frac{1}{8}$ feet long. How much ribbon does Sasha use in all?

3. Lisa's dog weighs 3 times as much as her cat. Lisa's cat weighs $1\frac{1}{2}$ times as much as Kelly's cat. Kelly's cat weighs $7\frac{1}{4}$ pounds. How many more pounds does Lisa's dog weigh than her cat?
