## Loss of our dear Brother-in-Christ, Roderic Moore



### From our dearly departed brother – Roderic Moore

The Seven Spiritual Gifts

It's amazing how, on occasion, knowledge will sneak up on you if you keep an open mind. This is a short recounting of something I stumbled across that ended up helping me, not only personally, but in my ministry.

The year was 2014. I hadn't really thought much about spiritual gifts beyond the fact that I had inventoried my own a few times, always with the same "top three" categorical results. But one day, while I was watching EWTN, the Catholic Church's dedicated TV channel, there was a 5-minute "filler" segment featuring as Franciscan Friar who was telling of his order's difficulties in getting children in catechesis to remember the seven gifts that Isaiah prophesied to belong to the coming Messiah (Chapter 11, verses 2 and 3). He demonstrated a mnemonic device, however, that he said completely – and almost instantly – solved the problem. Well, my interest was up, and I dropped what I was doing and tried the device. It worked beautifully – and, thanks to that, I know the seven gifts well to this day. Not only so, but the device played an important part in the interactive sermon I delivered in October 2016 as the concluding requirement of my process to qualify as a UMC Lay Speaker.

Here are the Isaiah verses under consideration (King James Version, gifts bolded): <sup>11:2</sup> And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; <sup>11:3</sup> And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears."

And here is the mnemonic: **WISDOM** – pat the top of your head. **KNOWLEDGE** – Point to your temple. **UNDERSTANDING** -- Point to one ear. **COUNSEL** – Touch your lips. MIGHT – Make a bicep muscle and grab it with your other hand. **PIETY** – Extend both hands forward and together, palms up. **FEAR OF THE LORD** -- Grab the sides of your head with both hands and make a frightened face.

The reason for the two interpretations of the phrase "fear of the Lord" seems to go back to the Latin Vulgate Bible by way of the Greek Septuagint, resulting in the verse 2 rendering of it as "pietas" (piety) and the verse 3 occurrence as "timoris domini" (fear of God). So we have seven gifts instead of an apparent six.

Piety is defined as reverence. According to Pope Francis, it's "a recognition of our belonging to God, our deep bond with him, a relationship that gives meaning to our whole life and keeps us resolute, in communion with him, even during the most difficult and troubled moments". And he adds that "Piety is not mere outward religiosity; it is that genuine religious spirit which makes us turn to the Father as his children and to grow in our love for others, seeing them as our brothers and sisters."

Per Wikipedia, fear of the Lord is akin to wonder (or awe). On this, Francis says that "it is not servile fear, but rather a joyful awareness of God's grandeur and a grateful realization that only in him do our hearts find true peace". A person with wonder and awe knows that God is the perfection of all one's desires." (And at this point I'm remembering J. S. Bach's timeless "Jesu, Joy of Man's Desiring.") Francis adds "This gift is described by (St. Thomas) Aquinas as a fear of separating oneself from God."

So seven gifts, the identity of the last two of which we will not make a scene about.


Anyway, if you try the mnemonic, and especially if you repeat it a couple of times, I guarantee that you'll never forget those gifts. And from there, you can start investigating the virtues that sprout from them.


