Garbage Collection

As a reminder, the town does not control the timing of garbage pickup by Empire Disposal, and sometimes there are substitute drivers or route changes based on the equipment they are using. Because of this, the best time to put out your garbage is the night before collection day or prior to 5:00am the morning of collection. This will decrease the chances of the Empire crew missing your garbage. If you are missed and had your garbage out during that time, please call Town Hall as soon as you notice (even leave a message after hours) so that we can coordinate with Empire Disposal.

Quick Tips

To conserve your water usage (and budget)

- Water your lawn or garden during the cool morning hours, as opposed to midday, to reduce evaporation.
- Use an automatic timer on your sprinkler or set a kitchen timer to remind you to turn off the water. Left unattended, a garden hose can waste as much as 600 gallons of water in just one hour!
- Lawns only need watering every 3 to 5 days in the summer. Watering more than 1 inch per week means you're just watering the ground below.
- Inspect irrigation systems and fix leaks and broken or clogged sprinkler heads. A broken sprinkler can waste 25,000 gallons in 6 months!
- Make sure you're watering the yard and not the street or driveway.
