Objectives and Outcomes:

- 1. Music Educators (ME) will perform repertoire appropriate to skill and technical development.
- 2. ME will incorporate tempo changes and variety of rhythms and meters in repertoire.
- 3. ME will demonstrate a variety of articulations: staccato, legato, accent, marcato, tenuto
- 4. ME will use dynamic contrast and technical skills as means of expression.
- 5. ME will demonstrate the ability to adjust and match pitches and to listen for beatless intonation between players.
- 6. ME will demonstrate an understanding (through performance and written exercises) how performance qualities are taught through the National Standards to refine performance technique.

Standards to be Addressed:

- #2. Performing on instruments, alone and with others, a varied repertoire of music.
- #5. Reading and notating music.
- #6. Listening to, analyzing, and describing music.
- #7. Evaluating music and music performances.
- #9. Understanding music in relation to history and culture.

Assessment:

- 1. ME will generate rubrics for assessment on performance techniques for repertoire currently teaching or planning to teach in public school.
- 2. Public performance of studied chamber repertoire within the workshop.
- 3. ME self-assessment of video-aped performance.
