#### **Fraudulent Activities**

On June 1<sup>st</sup>, the Deputy Clerk discovered a fraudulent charge was made on a second Village credit card. She has disputed the charge and the card has now been cancelled. As a precaution, we also cancelled the Mayor's Village-issued credit card.

We are currently reviewing policies and procedures concerning the handling of sensitive documents.

If this occurs again, we will file a report with the State Auditor's office and the State Police.

On June 1<sup>st</sup>, I discovered that I have been the victim of identity theft and that one or more credit cards had been opened in my name. At this time, we do not have evidence that this incident is related to the Village issues, but further investigations will take place.

#### **EMS**

EMS Coordinator James Nelson reported that there were six EMS calls in the month of May 2020.

#### **FIRE**

Mayor Rumpf reported that there one fire reported in the month of May. It turned out to be a trash fire.

#### **PUBLIC WORKS**

Mayor Rumpf reported that Jacob Finch would be working with the water crew on the 2019 Consumer Confidence Report that gets submitted to the New Mexico Environment Department. The staff has been working on the weeds in the alleys and around Village Hall. He also mentioned that much of the area was under a *Red Flag Warning* for the last three days, meaning fire danger is high.

BOHANNAN HUSTON, INC. AND JOHN SHOMAKER & ASSOCIATES - VILLAGE OF MAGDALENA WATER WELL & SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT STATUS REPORT AND HYDROGEOLOGIC INVESTIGATION REPORT

John Shomaker and Associates representative Andrew P. Feltman presented a PowerPoint covering: Magdalena Well Investigations, Magdalena Waterline Replacement along US60 broken down into Phase 1 and Phase. An outline of the presentation went as follows:

Participating in the discussion with Village Trustees were Bohannan Huston representatives; Todd Burt, Jared Lam, Nathan Roberts, and Donzil Worthington.

Trustee Conrad noted that it had been stressed that the material used to construct the existing wells is carbon steel and asked if this is an issue in the degradation of the current wells and if so were they recommending a material upgrade.

The Bohannan representative stated that they were recommending an upgrade to 304L stainless steel.

Trustee Conrad asked an analysis of the water would be performed to ensure that there were no elements in the water that would adversely affect the 304L stainless steel.

The Bohannan representative confirmed that a water analysis would be done.

Trustee Conrad requested to review the well completion plan.

The plan was posted for viewing and the Bohannan representative confirmed the critical dimensions of the well completion. The critical dimensions confirmed were the conductor casing, the surface casing the well casing and the length of the perforated section at the bottom of the well riser.

Per Bohannan Huston representatives:

- a Federally required Categorical Exclusion is being prepared at this time.
- Permit applications are being processed.
- The initial highway crossing bore project and the previous professional services tasks and
  invoices have and will all be coming out of the two existing New Mexico state SAP Jr. Bill grants.
  These are close to being fully utilized so in the near future we should be drawing funds from the
  Drinking Water State Revolving Fund award through the NMFA Office, Todd Johansen/s
  program, which are combination State Funds and Federal Funds, so are administered by the
  more stringent federal funding requirements.
- The public will have an opportunity to provide input on this project.

One sealed bid was received, opened, and read aloud on June 2, 2020, at 2:15 pm on-line in a Microsoft Teams meeting due to the Covid-19 Public Heath Order.

The bid has been evaluated and is shown on the attached bid abstract.

All required documents were submitted with the bid. The required bid bonds were submitted.

The bid appears to be reasonable for the work anticipated. The two addenda issued during the bidding process were acknowledged. The prime contractor has a current registration with the Labor Enforcement Fund. None of the listed subcontractors meet the criteria for registration with the Labor Enforcement Fund.

Labor Enforcement Fund for the prime contractor was verified. The contractor is not on the Federal suspended or disbarred contractor listing, nor is on the State list of suspended or debarred contractors. The Bid Bond was issued by a company listed in Federal Register Circular 570.

All other bidding requirements appear to be in compliance with the bidding documents. The contractor bid evaluation is attached.

BHI has consulted with the FAA and NMAD on funding available for this project. The FAA funding is limited to \$150,000 plus an additional \$16,667 CARES Act supplement for a FAA total of \$166,667.00. The funding shortfall has been discussed with NMAD staff and the shortfall requested of NMAD. A NMAD Grant amendment or new grant will be necessary once we have a decision on funding from NMAD.

Based on this we recommend the Village of Magdalena accept the bid for the Magdalena Municipal Airport – Runway Safety Area Grading and Obstruction Removals, subject to the concurrence of the Federal Aviation Administration and the NMDOT – Aviation Division, and receipt of the actual grants; award a contract for the Base Bid, additive Alternate 1, and Additive Alternate 2 in the amount of \$ 239,449.00 excluding NMGRT.

NMGRT at the current Village rate of **7.4375** should be included in the project budget for an overall construction budget amount of **\$ 257,258.02**.




