Information We Collect. Most of the data and information we collect through our website is used only to help us achieve our mission. It is our policy to collect and store only personal information that our clients knowingly provide.

Casual Web Site Visitors and General Users. Big Children's Foundation does not collect any personal information from users browsing our website. Clients, Donors and Other Customers.
