March's Meeting Minutes:

Seneschal's Report: Honorable Lady Aesa reported that she got the list of 17 former TADs members. She will write up a "Welcome to Windhaven" letter and give out the information so that the new Windys can see what we have to offer.

Chatelaine Report: Lady Wynne contacted librarians about demos and received the Gold Key for her position. She is asking for volunteers to teach new people. There will be a sewing class coming up to teach basic garb making during the Windy Tuesdays events you can following on Facebook located at Menasha Public Library 440 1st St. Menasha, WI 54952 from 5:30-8pm. Lady Wynne is also planning on contacting Lady Taleza (new MoAS) so that she knows the different arts and science activities being taught as well as which people are teaching the different activities. She will also talk to THL Birna to create facebook events as well. Lady Wynne also appointed a new Deputy Chatelaine, Bridget to assist with tasks. Bridget created a QR code that we can now put out during practices and activities for others to see our information for new people.

Exchequer Report: Hilde Steward reported that Pay-pal is set up for Crown. A down payment for the site has been made as well. There was a credit towards the cost from Fighter's School so it wasn't as much as originally thought. There are only 4 XL t-shirts available so make sure to put in your request soon. Also there are some Known World Handbooks available for new people interested.

Chronicler's Report: Lady Eyfríðr reported that the VI was written and sent via email. During Officer's Week, they had voted to keep the creation and distribution of the VI as a Chronicler's duty instead of placing it with another office as that can be a lot to add to another's duties. If a group wants to double up the position with another (meaning the Webminister or Social Media officer is also the Chronicler), they can as there is no Society/Kingdom rule stating that it isn't allowed. She did bring up that our Baronial laws state that Chronicler is a Major office and therefore can't be doubled up with another office position. But this is a local law and can be changed if/when we wish in the future. At this time, there is no need to change this law as we have plenty of people to take the different officer positions.

MoAS: Lady Taleza reported that there has been (or will have soon) weaving, illumination, garb and leather workshops. She is working with Lady Wynne (new Chatelaine) to find out who is teaching what activities exactly.

Herald's Report: Lady Orlaith worked with others on 6 names and 4 devices. She is updating the OP and just found out that she needed to be sending the names of reward recipients to the Chronicler for the VI so that they can be posted in the future. Herald position will be voted on in May. **Knight's Marshal's Report:** Lord Hamish reported that there are no practices currently going on. But took 4 new fighters that were interested in heavy combat and made a game plan for their armor so that they can start combat training. Lord Hamish volunteered to be the new Knights Marshall.

Rapier Marshal's Report: Wilhelm von Mansfeld reported that he got his event report and quarterly report in on time. There are no official practices yet but he will talk to the new Knights Marshal when it dries up.

Archery Captain: Lord Luca reported that there are no practices yet until it dries up. He will have his 1 year renewal in April so it will be posted in the VI and voted on in May. He is interested in continuing if there are no other interested parties.

Web Minister's Report: Lord Luca reported that the VI was posted to the site. Officers were updated on the website and the new emails were put into place for forwarding emails. The page on the website for Crown event has been built and he is waiting for approval to make sure there are no mistakes. Schenescal asked for access to the calendar to make adding events easier in the future. Also Webminister will be up in April so it will be posted in the VI and voted on in May.
