Background & Purpose

.75% municipal income tax to offset projected budget deficit due to state cuts
Estimated to generate \$98,000 additional funds per year
Current budget surplus due to collecting more than predicted
Survey to assess public input of the townspeople in regards to spending surplus funds

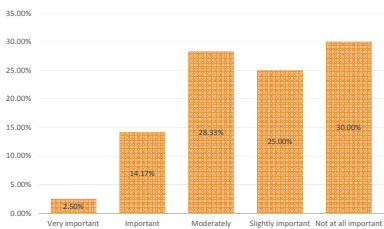
Methodology

Sample size was generated from current registered voters
446 registered voters received a mailed survey
149 surveys were returned, resulting in a 33% response rate

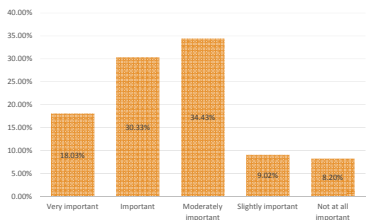
Demographic and Household Profile

70% of respondents have no minor children living at home
71% of respondents are married; 26% are single; 3% are cohabitating
Respondents have lived in Wayne an average of 25.6 years
86% of respondents own their home, while 14% rent

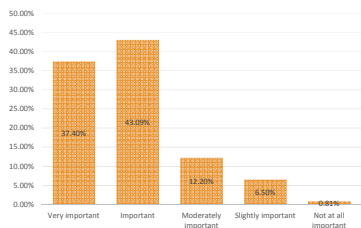
Opinion on Community Center Spending



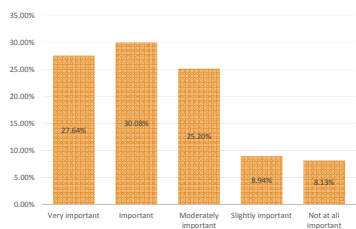
Opinion on Park Spending



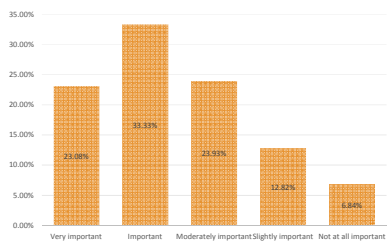
Opinion on Street Spending

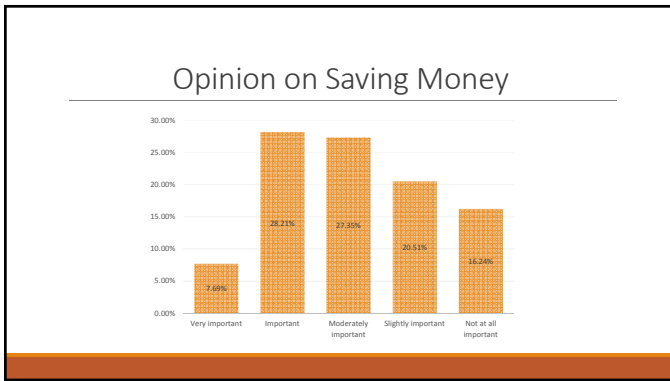


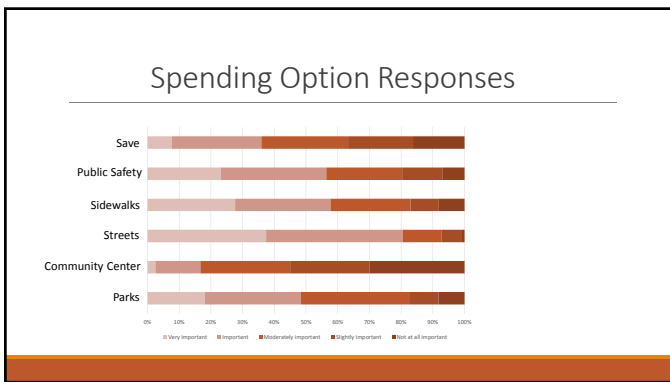
Opinion on Sidewalk Spending

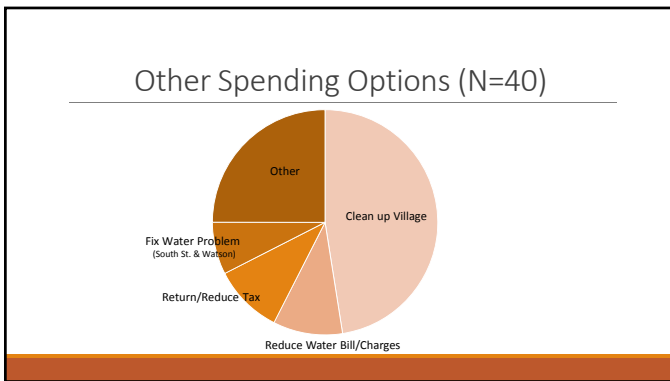


Opinion on Public Safety Spending
