Called Meeting

October 26, 2017 at 9:00 A.M.

The Lanier County Board of Commissioners met at a Called Meeting on October 26, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. in the Board of Commissioner's office. Those present at the meeting were Chairman, Alex Lee, Commissioners, Harold Simpson, Dennis Fender and Susan Bowling. Commissioner Paul Brockington was not present at the meeting. The County Administrator, Neil Ginty and the County Clerk, Donna Studstill were also present at the meeting.

Chairman Alex Lee called the meeting to order. Mr. Jim Kelley gave the Invocation.

Commissioner Bowling made a motion to accept the Agenda Commissioner Simpson seconded the motion. All were in favor.

The County Administrator, Neil Ginty, discussed the Resolution 2018 Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant with the Board. Administrator Ginty explained that the Resolution is a requirement for the grant with Southern Georgia Regional Commission. There will be a 50% match for the grant that the County will be responsible for the funds. Commissioner Fender made a motion to approve the Resolution. Commissioner Bowling seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Commissioner Simpson spoke to the Board concerning the 4-H team needing a place to practice skeet shooting. Administrator Ginty stated that Matt Hart with the Boy Scouts spoke to him and suggested using the Boy Scout Camp on Burnt Church Road. In addition, they can use the machines they have. Anyone wanting to use the facility will need to call and reserve the time. Commissioner Simpson made a motion to approve this area for 4-H skeet. Commissioner Fender seconded the motion. All were in favor.

There being no further business, Commissioner Fender made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Bowling seconded the motion. All were in favor.
