



## CIWI 2025. Sponsorship Options

Sponsorship Options	Overview of Option	Onboarding, Hourly Rate, and Total Fee	Payment and Timing
Base Option	<p>Intern works for the Sponsor firm for 240 hours (approx. 20 hrs./wk.) and also participates in the Civic Engagement Program (approx. 40 hrs.) during the summer.</p> <p>Total is 280 hours for the CIWI base option internship.</p>	<p>Intern is onboarded as an employee of Community Initiatives (CI)/CIWI. CI is the fiscal sponsor.</p> <p>CIWI pays the intern \$22/hr.</p> <p>Total Sponsor fee is \$11,000.</p>	<p>Sponsor pays 50% of Sponsor fee (\$5,500) to CIWI within 30 days of when the intern is selected/placed.</p> <p>The other 50% (\$5,500) is paid by 5/31/25.</p>
Alternate Option	<p>Sponsor pays the intern directly and can employ the intern 20 to 40 hrs./wk.</p> <p>Ideally the Intern also attends the 40-hour Civic Engagement Program, with time paid by the Sponsor.</p>	<p>Intern is Sponsor employee and is onboarded accordingly by the Sponsor.</p> <p>Sponsor pays the intern directly <b>at least</b> \$22/hr.</p> <p>Sponsor fee to CIWI is \$5,000.</p>	<p>Sponsor pays CIWI fee (\$5,000) within 30 days of when the intern is selected/placed.</p>

There are two phases to the intern selection. Phase 1 placements occurs in early 2025 (Jan./Feb). Phase 2 placements occurs in the Spring (Apr/May). Intern resumes are provided by CIWI to the Sponsors, Sponsors short-list and interview as desired, then CIWI places the interns based on shortlist and availability. **CIWI 2025.INTERESTED SPONSORS.
