Lay Leader's Report

The Disciple I Bible study course is about to enter its final week. After about a year of weekly readings and discussions, the last formal session will be on Monday, August 22.

Acting for the Trustees in the interest of maintaining proper oversight of PPL billing, I have created a spreadsheet power usage and cost tracking system that will insure that all PPL bills are inspected and recorded in detail as soon as we get the statements for each of our three locations.

On July 28 I visited with some administrative friends of mine at the Lutheran Theological Seminary in Gettysburg. At that time, I donated to their campus archive a second-edition (1868) copy of Martin Luther's landmark "Table Talk" in English translation, a book that had been destined for riddance during the Bethany library cleanout earlier in 2016. I also attended a Lay School class that was being conducted as part of a yearly series offered by the Seminary on an ecumenical basis, and I met for casual conversations with several people in the LTSG Department of Advancement. I have been invited back to the Seminary in the Fall to audit a class on homiletics, a field of special interest to me.

There are new and more intensive courses being offered by the District for Lay Speaker certification, and I will be pursuing 5 courses in the Fall to complete my qualification in that area. Some of the classes will be on line, and some will require personal attendance and participation in sermon delivery sessions. I thank Pastor Damien for helping me obtain the necessary books for these classes in the most cost-effective way possible.

On behalf of all Bethany members, I express again the great sorrow we felt here when we heard of the recent passing of Sharon Budd's husband Randy. It will be recalled that they were the victims of last year's Interstate 80 rock-dropping incident that resulted in Sharon's horrific injury and lengthy hospitalization. God bless her, and God bless her family, now and always.

We were recently able to take advantage of a generous vendor policy that allowed us to return almost all of our unused 2016 VBS supplies for a substantial savings. That's a significant and welcome church budget line item "plus," and a big "thank you" goes to Pastor Damien and the Christian Education Committee for making it happen.

Christ Evangelical Lutheran Church has asked to join us for VBS in 2017, and the Board quickly and gladly approved of that by unanimous vote.

The Trustees are going to investigate possible ways to arrange the rooms in the Parish House to increase the work and storage space available to those who work in the office. The current situation, in which several people must share the use of one room in the whole building as a base of operations, is fast becoming untenable and the next thing to counter-productive.

Some Bethany members took part in the August 20 run/walk that benefits Love, Inc., and the church is looking to engage multiple participants in the October 9 Milton World Hunger CROP Walk. Bethany is a partner church with Love Inc. / Milton, which is a non-profit faith based organization whose primary purpose is to make connections between volunteers willing to help with specific needs and clients with those same unmet needs in the local community. CROP Hunger Walks are interfaith hunger education and fundraising events sponsored by Church World Service through local offices across the United States.
