RCIA News *An Invitation to Come!*

RCIA Sessions are open to Catholics who wish to learn more about our Faith. The RCIA sessions are on Sundays from 10:00 a.m. - 11:15 a.m. in the Chapel meeting room.

The Sessions for November/December will be:

November 20 - Advent

December 4 - Mary

December 11 - Christian Morality and the Dignity of the Human Person - Heaven, Hell, and Purgatory

Why do the catechumens, (adults preparing for baptism), leave Mass after the Liturgy of the Word?

The catechumens are being dismissed after the Liturgy of the Word to prepare them for the time when they can be dismissed to do the work of the faithful. So, when they are dismissed, they are continuing rather than ending their worship. Their going out after the Liturgy of the Word is an opportunity to provide additional nourishment of the Word of God at a time when they cannot participate in the Eucharist. It also brings to the attention of our Saint Olaf community, that we have catechumens among us that we should "give help to those who are searching for Christ". (RCIA 9).

The prayer for the catechumens describes this beautifully "My dear friends this community now sends you forth to reflect more deeply upon the Word of God which you have shared with us today. Be assured of our loving support and prayers for you. We look forward to the day when you will share fully in the Lord's Table." (RCIA 96)
