# <u>Be Still, Be Quiet, Be Patient, Be Peaceful</u>

Nope, not usually those things on a Christmas list, but they are the themes for Advent worship. Often, we begin the season of Advent like expectant parents in the final four weeks of pregnancy. Wondering what the child will look like. Will he have his dad's eyes and broad shoulders? Will she have her mom's smile and small feet? We wait to see what the baby looks like and that is often how we approach Advent and then the Christmas season, too.

What if we spent the four weeks leading up to Christmas, not wondering who the baby will look like, but rather we spend this time being reminded of the *continual presence* of Jesus in our lives. We then know what this baby, born in a feed trough, would do for the world.

Sometimes it takes a crisis to get our attention and pull us back to recognize that God is and always has been with God's people. During this season of Advent, let it take *Christ* to pull our attention back to recognize his presence in our lives. The writer of Hebrews declares, *"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday today and forever." (Hebrews 13:8)* Jesus is the same constant oneness, Emmanuel, God with us. He became fully human. We enter Advent looking for glimpses of the promises of the *return* of the King of Kings, the Lord of Lords, Emmanuel, the Savior of the World, Jesus! We will gather for worship during Advent, and learn together to be still, quiet, patient and peaceful.

ADOPTION OF AGENDA: The agenda for November was adopted with the following additions:

ADOPTION OF MINUTES: The minutes for the October council meeting were accepted.

## **REPORTS:**

Pastor Gina gave a report for November.

Emily Morris, Treasurer, presented a report for October. She noted one mistake under Children's Designated Contributions, and will make this change. Annette Price, Financial Secretary, submitted a report for October.

# **BOARD/COMMITTEE REPORTS/BUSINESS:**

- 1. Property: Wall in Pastor Gina's office will be painted.
- 2. IT Committee: Wayne Eargle presented a proposal given to us by Spectrum for bundled services. This will give us better and added services for a lower cost. A motion was made and seconded to move forward with the bundled package price quoted to us. **Passed** Discussion was held about the age of the current telephones. We have the wiring/capability for new equipment now. Wayne will investigate cost to replace these and bring it back to council as information.
- 3. Education: Question was asked about whether or not there would be a Children's Christmas program. Pastor Gina looking into having them participate in a Worship service for this.
- 4. Worship: Advent services will be held at 6:35 with a meal after. Christmas Eve service will be held at 7 pm, with music beginning at 6:35.
- 5. Other: Diane Boulware is working out dates for the Free Garage Sale. Pastor Gina will work with Brittany to make sure all dates for Fellowship Hall use are on the calendar to avoid any over-booking.

# **OLD BUSINESS:**

1. Farming Church: The Leadership Plan developed was given to all. Cluster Gathering webinar will be November 13 at 6 pm. Council was asked to review the 4 questions emailed to them before the webinar.

- 2. Cemetery: A group has been put together through Finance to review all the church's contracts and payments. Cemetery/yard upkeep is included in this.
- 3. Council Ballot: Ballot for Congregational meeting has been set. Nominated by council: Wynne Price, Ronnie Fulmer, Robin Ellisor, Earl Sease, and Bryce Addy (youth). Nominated by congregation: Marion Leaphart, Joey Koon, Missy Addy, Buddy Hydrick, Mitch Stevens (youth).
- 4. Safety committee: Working to get this going again.
- 5. Parsonage Task Force: Al working to get committee together and develop a task list.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1. Congregational Meeting: Agenda was developed.
- 2. A letter was received from 7<sup>th</sup> Day Adventist Church requesting to rent our building on Wednesday Evening and Saturdays. Pastor Gina contacted them to decline.
- 3. Community Thanksgiving service will be held on November 20 at All Saints Episcopal
- 4. Copier: Discussion held about current copiers. A sheet has been placed on the copier in the workroom to determine how many members are using this copier. Brittany spends several hours each week printing, stapling, and folding the bulletins. Pastor Gina has contacted several companies and has been given a proposal for a new service contract and a finishing unit. This unit would complete all of these tasks. Cost would be \$1,700 or can be financed (interest free) for 12 months. The lease and service agreements for both copiers will be reviewed and when this information is received council will be polled by email on whether or not to proceed with this purchase.
- 5. We received a letter from Lutheran Men in Mission requesting that our church support the Pee Dee Indian Project. A motion was made that we use Advent and Christmas offerings toward this. **Passed.**

After Feedback, the meeting was adjourned with praying the Lord's Prayer.
