

H. H. GOULD, FORMER PIGEON MAN DIES IN DENVER

Word was received in Pigeon this week that Harry H. Gould died in Denver, Colorado, on September 16, after an illness of several months.

Harry H. Gould was for many years engaged in the implement business in Pigeon and platted what is known as the Gould Addition in this village. He erected the carriage factory building, later occupied by Black's Department store. The building was destroyed by fire.

Mr. Gould left Pigeon and located in Oklahoma about twenty years ago. Later he located in Denver, Colorado, where he spent the balance of his life. In both Oklahoma and Denver he conducted an investment company.

Deceased is survived by his wife and one daughter Mrs. Lafayette Steadman.
