I want to thank everyone who came down to pool clean-up day held 05/08/21. Your help was greatly appreciated. Saturday 05/22/21 (opening day) is just around the corner, I hope you all are as excited as I am for the swim club to open!!

The Board of Directors voted unanimously to open this season on time following all of the Fairfax County guidelines for outdoor swim clubs. Guidelines can be found at www.fairfaxcounty.gov/health/novel-coronavirus/pools. The swim club will open following the 75% maximum occupancy allowed within the gates, this includes during swim/dive team events, weekends, and holidays. Once capacity is reached, members will be allowed to check in on a "one out - one in" basis. We appreciate your patience as we control the occupancy levels.

Face coverings will be required during the check-in/check-out process and while in the restrooms. The restrooms will be closed periodically for 15-minute intervals for cleaning (an announcement will be made in advance), we will provide cleaning materials so all furniture can be cleaned between uses.

The snack bar will be open, during regular hours and for swim/dive meets, selling only prepackaged foods. We will begin the season holding off on allowing guest and pavilion rentals until the attendance numbers allow for added people without shareholders/lease holders being affected.

The Hayfield Farm Swim and Dive Teams are back this year and competing in the Northern Virginia Swim League (NVSL) with other swim and dive teams in the surrounding communities across Northern Virginia. Things will be slightly different this year as we incorporate current COVID protocol but it will still be a season of friendships, fast swimming, awesome diving and sportsmanship! In order to design practices under the COVID protocols registration will close on May 15th.

Head Swim Coach Jenny with Swim Coaches Kate, Aaron, Bella, Emme and Liz and Head Dive Coach George with Dive Coaches Lauren and Lucy are all excited to work with our swimmers and divers! Our team begins after-school practices on the Tuesday after Memorial Day (June 1) and switches to morning practices on Monday, June 14th. Many of our team members have conflicting activities, so don't worry if you cannot make all of the practices. We will have competitive meets and B meets this summer. Swimmers and divers must be registered before starting practice.

All new swimmers need an evaluation.

We have a new suit this year. The team suit sale is scheduled for Sunday, May 23, from 6:00-8:00 at the pool or can be purchased online at

In addition, Hayfield Pool also has a pre-swim team program called Mini Hawks.
